

# THE OKLAHOMA CITY GUN CLUB PROGRAM

## 2018 CMP APPROVED HIGHPOWER RIFLE MATCHES

**February 25, April 29, May 27, June 22-24, September 30, November 25, December 30**

**RANGE LOCATION:** Three miles north of Arcadia, OK, on Anderson Rd. At the corner of Anderson Rd. and Sorghum Mill Rd., turn east and proceed ½ mile. Turn left, enter the gate to the property and follow the signs to the clubhouse / range. See attached map.

**Street Address:** 12465 NE 234<sup>th</sup> Street, Arcadia, OK 73007

**RULES:** Current CMP rules will govern. It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with CMP rules and this program. The CMP classification system will be used (Rule 5.11.4). Competitors who do not have a CMP Classification, but who have an NRA Classification may compete with their current NRA Classification for their first match (Rule 5.11.4 (f)).

**ELIGIBILITY:** See rule 4.0

**Registration:** Registration for matches at the Steve Baldwin Club House will open one hour before matches begin and close thirty minutes before matches begin. Pre-registration is authorized only for the Service Rifle Extravaganza.

Fee: \$10 per gun; Juniors shoot free

27 MAY, following the President's Match

24 JUN, following the EIC Match

### **COURSES OF FIRE:**

#### 800 point XTC - CMP Highpower Rifle Standard Course (Rule 8.11)

Match#1: 200 YD SF, Target SR. Standing, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match#2: 200 YD RF, Target SR. Sitting or kneeling, 2 sighting shots, 2-10 shot strings in 60 seconds per string.

Match#3: 300 YD RF, Target SR-3, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 2-10 shot strings in 70 seconds per string.

Match#4: 600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match#5: Aggregate Match: Total of Matches #1 thru #4.

#### 1000 point XTC - CMP Highpower Rifle Standard Course (Rule 8.12)

Match#1: 200 YD SF, Target SR. Standing, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match#2: 200 YD RF, Target SR. Sitting or kneeling, 2 sighting shots, 2-10 shot strings in 60 seconds per string.

Match#3: 300 YD RF, Target SR-3, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 2-10 shot strings in 70 seconds per string.

Match#4: 500 YD SF, Target MR, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match#5: 600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match#6: Aggregate Match: Total of Matches #1 thru #5.

#### President's Match - CMP Highpower Rifle Standard Course (Rule 8.3.1)

Stage 1. 200 YD SF, Target SR. Standing slow fire, 10 shots for record, 10 minutes.

Stage 2. 300 YD RF, Target SR-3, Prone rapid fire, 1-10 shot strings in 70 seconds.

Stage 3. 600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone, 10 shots for record, 10 minutes.

Final Stage. 600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone, President's Practice Shoot Off (fun match), (Rule 8.3.2) 10x50 second exposures, 10 shots total – total points from the practice shoot off will not be forwarded to the CMP and will be scored on a separate score card – the intent of this string is practice for the actual President's 100 Rifle Match.

#### EIC Match - CMP Highpower Rifle Standard Course (Rule 8.4.1)

200 YD SF, Target SR. Standing Slow Fire, 10 shots for record, 10 minutes.

200 YD RF, Target SR. Sitting or kneeling, 1-10 shot String, 60 seconds per string.

300 YD RF, Target SR-3, Prone Rapid Fire, 1-10 shot string, 70 seconds per string.

600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone Slow Fire, 20 shots for record, 20 minutes.

#### GSM Match - CMP Highpower Rifle Standard Course (Rule 4.5.1, CMP Games)

200 YD SF, Target SR. Prone Slow Fire, 5 sighting shots, 10 record shots, 15 minutes.

200 YD SF, Target SR. Prone Rapid Fire, 10 record shots, 80 seconds.

200 YD SF, Target SR. Standing Slow Fire, 10 record shots, 10 minutes.

XTC Team Match - (Rule 8.5.2):

200 YD SF, Target SR. Standing Slow Fire, 10 shots for record, 10 minutes.

200 YD RF, Target SR. Sitting or kneeling, 1-10 shot String, 60 seconds per string.

300 YD RF, Target SR-3, Prone Rapid Fire, 1-10 shot string, 70 seconds per string.

600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone Slow Fire, 20 shots for record, 20 minutes.

All slow fire stages will be pair fired.

Each team may have a nonfiring coach and captain.

Each team will be required to perform scoring and pit duties, but these need not be firing members.

**AUTHORIZED RIFLES:**

Rifles authorized for these matches include M16/AR15 Type Service Rifle (Rule 6.1.1), CMP Alternative Rifle (Rule 6.1.2), CMP Match Rifle (Rule 6.1.5), M14 Type Service Rifle (Rule 6.1.3), and M1 Garand Type Service Rifle (Rule 6.1.4).

**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

No lunch breaks - Bring whatever you require to sustain you through the matches. Water may not be available on the range

Competitors will be required to perform score keeping duties and operate targets.

**AWARDS:**

Cash awards will be paid for all matches except for EIC and GSM matches.

Based on ½ entry fees received. Classes may be combined upward if less than 6 entries (Rule 5.11.4 (e)). The High Master class will not be combined with other classes. Awards will go to the overall winners of each match (1-4 or 1-5) and the match aggregate. Class awards will be awarded based on the match aggregate: One award per 3 entries in each class, up to a total of 3 places. All Unclassified Competitors will fire in the Master class.
