

F-Class SBR (22 rimfire)

F-Class SBR is an NRA provisional match being in 2017. The match was developed to replicate the High-Power F-Class competition but shot at 50 meters or yards, and 100 yards instead of 600-1000 yards used in High Power.

This a prone match shooting (3) 20 shot stages at 100 yards.

Location: Oklahoma City Gun Club, Muzzling loading Range # 2 (east side).

Dates: **3/11, 4/8, 5/13, 6/10, 7/8, 8/12, 10/21, 11/11** (no match in September)
Always check the club calendar for changes or cancelations.

Time: Registration 7:30AM – 8:15AM Match 9:00AM – 2:00PM

Coarse of Fire: (3) 20 shots stages for a total of 60 record rounds @ 100 yards (3X100)

Divisions: Target Rifle (FTR) use of bipod, rear bag rest, weight limit 18.18#, includes bipod and sights or scope (no power limit)

F-Open (F0) use of bipod or machine rest, rear bag rest, weight limit 22 # includes sights or scope (no power limit)

Sporter – (FS) use of folding bipod similar to Harris, fixed wing type bipods are prohibited, rear bag rest without ears, any sights/scope, weight limit 10.5# including bipod and sights or scope (no power limit)

Sights: Any sight or scope, there is no power limit on scopes. Scopes are recommended.

Actions: Any action other the tubular magazines are allowed however the rifle can only be loaded as a single shot, single shot adapters are available for most actions. Loading on top of a magazine or loading only one round in a magazine is allowable.
