

**THE OKLAHOMA CITY GUN CLUB**  
**2022 (MID-RANGE) NRA INTERNATIONAL**  
**FULLBORE PRONE HIGHPOWER MATCHES**  
**Mar 20, May 22, July 17**

**RANGE LOCATION:** 12465 N.E. 234th, Arcadia, OK. Three miles north of Arcadia, OK, on Anderson Rd. At the corner of Anderson Rd. and Sorghum Mill Rd., turn east and proceed roughly half a mile where you can enter the gate on the north side of the road. Proceed through the gate and take a left on the range road.

**REGISTRATION:** All 2022 matches will be entered into PractiScore.com - early registration is encouraged and appreciated. The morning of the match, registration will be in the Gary Stephens High Power Rifle Club House beginning at 8:00 AM and will end at 8:30 AM. Competitors registering through PractiScore must check in at the club house prior to 8:30. Shooting will begin at 9:00 AM.

**RULES:** Current NRA rules will govern. It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with NRA rules and this program. Please become familiar with the following NRA International Full Bore Rules: <https://competitions.nra.org/competition-resources/rule-books/>

All matches will be pair firing (two to a mound) 2 convertible sighting shots and 15 shots for record at each yard line. Relays 1 & 3 will be the shooters on the right. Relays 2 and 4 will be shooters on the left. Each shooter will be expected to fire within 45 seconds from the time the previous score has been accepted. Shooters on the same mound will score for each other during each match. There may be a burn off period prior to the first string of fire and there may be unlimited sighting shots for the first matches at the discretion of the match director.

Matches 1-4, categories will be Service Rifle, PALMA Rifle, Match Rifle, and Match Rifle with Optics; (Adding Tactical Rifle AR - TR-AR pending rules). If fewer than three entries are in a category/classification, Service will be combined with Match and Match combined with Match with Optics. These categories will compete for aggregate awards and individual matches.

Matches 1 and 5, 2 and 6, 3 and 7 will be fired concurrently.

For matches 5-8, categories will be F-T/R, and F-Open. If fewer than three entries are in a category/classification, they will be combined. These categories will compete for aggregate awards and individual matches. Matches 1 and 5, 2 and 6, 3 and 7 will be fired concurrently.

**ENTRIES:** Open to any individual. If you are an NRA member, it is necessary to furnish your NRA membership number to enter.

**FEES:** Entry fees: \$20.00; Juniors: \$10.00; Challenge fee: \$5.00

**MATCH SCHEDULE:** Match begins @ 9:00AM

**COURSE OF FIRE:**

Match#1: 300 YD SF, Target MR-63, Prone, 2 sighting shots convertible, 15 shots for record.

Match#2: 500 YD SF, Target MR-65, Prone, 2 sighting shots convertible, 15 shots for record.

Match#3: 600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone, 2 sighting shots convertible, 15 shots for record.

Match#4: Aggregate of Matches #1-#3.

Match#5: 300 YD SF, Target MR-63-F, Prone, 2 sighting shots convertible.

Match#6: 500 YD SF, Target MR-65-F, Prone, 2 sighting shots convertible, 15 shots for record.

Match#7: 600 YD SF, Target MR-1-F, Prone, 2 sighting shots convertible, 15 shots for record.

Match#8: Aggregate of Matches #5-#7.

**COMPETITOR DUTIES:** Competitors will be required to perform score keeping duties and operate targets if the ShotMarker scoring system is not operational or is available. All matches are currently planned to use the Shot Marker scoring system; please bring a WIFI capable device for scoring and or individual use.

**AWARDS:** One half entry fees minus NRA fees will be divided up among winners. Classes will be combined if less than three (3) entries. First and Second Place Aggregate and Individual match winners will be awarded. Second place class awards in the aggregate if eight (8) entries. Third place class awards in the aggregate if thirteen (13) entries. The awards system will be altered at times to accommodate the specific aspect of the monthly match and at the discretion of the match director.
