2025 Club AR-Tactical Matches

May 4, July 13, August 10, September 14, October 12

Range Location: Proceed three miles north of Arcadia, OK, on Anderson Rd. At the corner of Anderson Rd. and Sorghum Mill Rd., turn east and proceed ½ mile. Turn left, entering the gate to the property and follow the road to the T, take a left and follow the road to the High Power range. Proceed north on the range road to the 300 yard line.

Street Address: 12465 NE 234th Street, Arcadia, OK 73007

Rules: Current CMP rules will govern with the exception that the match will be shot at a distance of 300yds. It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with CMP rules and this program.

Registration: Registration is at the 300 yard line of the High Power Rifle Range, and will open at 12:00, thirty minutes before matches begin, closing at 12:30.

Fee: \$15 / Juniors shoot free

Match Information: Tactical-AR matches have recently been adopted by the CMP and NRA due to the popularity of the AR-15 and AR-10 platforms. If a competitor is not "on paper" after two shots, the competitor will stop firing until a match official can assist with spotting shots and zero adjustments.

Course of Fire: The course of fire is "Slow Fire" meaning rifles are loaded one round at a time. Shots are displayed on the targets and scored before the next shot is fired, giving competitors the opportunity to make sight adjustments between shots. The match will consist of three strings each of sighting shots followed by 15 shots for record in a time limit of 17 minutes. Unlimited sighters are authorized for the first string of fire and only two sighters are authorized for the last two strings.

Firing Position: The position is considered F-class wherein a bipod or backpack is used to support the rifle in the prone position. An unattached rear bag (without "ears") is authorized.

Coaching: Coaching is authorized.

Authorized Rifles and Ammo:

Barrel Length maximum 20"

Optics maximum power 16x - may be taped at 16 if scope is capable of greater magnification

Caliber- not limited to just .223rem or .308win, but not greater than .35cal

Projectile must be supersonic and stable at 300yds

No muzzle breaks

Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) must be used and may be purchased for \$1

Out of competition:

Rifles not complying with the above paragraph may be used but will fire out of competition. Only exceptions is no muzzle breaks and/or calibers in excess of .35 caliber are prohibited.

Target: MR-63 (2.85" x-ring, 5.85" 10-ring)

Competitor Duties: Competitors will be required to perform scoring duties and may be required to operate targets if the electronic target system is not available. OKCGC members will be asked to secure the pits after the match.

Prizes: Prizes are at the discretion of the match director.
