RANGE LOCATION: 12465 N.E. 234th, Arcadia, OK. Three miles north of Arcadia, OK, on Anderson Rd. At the corner of Anderson Rd. and Sorghum Mill Rd., turn east and proceed roughly half a mile where you can enter the gate on the north side of the road. Proceed through the gate and take a left on the range road.

STREET ADDRESS: 12465 NE 234th Street, Arcadia, OK 73007

RULES: Current CMP rules will govern. It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with CMP rules and this program. The CMP classification system will be used (Rule 5.11.4). Competitors who do not have a CMP Classification, but who have an NRA Classification may compete with their current NRA Classification for their first match (Rule 5.11.4 (f)).

ELIGIBILITY: See rule 4.0

REGISTRATION: Registration in the Gary Stephens High Power Rifle Club House will begin at 8:00 AM and will end at 8:30 AM the day of each match. Shooting will begin at 9:00 AM.

COURSES OF FIRE:

1000 point XTC - CMP Highpower Rifle Standard Course (Rule 8.12)

Match#1: 200 YD SF, Target SR. Standing, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match#2: 200 YD RF, Target SR. Sitting or kneeling, 2 sighting shots, 2-10 shot strings in 60 seconds per string.

Match#3: 300 YD RF, Target SR-3, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 2-10 shot strings in 70 seconds per string.

Match#4: 600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match#5: 600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match#6: Aggregate Match: Total of Matches #1 thru #5.

800 point XTC - CMP Highpower Rifle Standard Course (Rule 8.11)

Match#1: 200 YD SF, Target SR. Standing, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match#2: 200 YD RF, Target SR. Sitting or kneeling, 2 sighting shots, 2-10 shot strings in 60 seconds per string.

Match#3: 300 YD RF, Target SR-3, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 2-10 shot strings in 70 seconds per string.

Match#4: 600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes.

Match#5: Aggregate Match: Total of Matches #1 thru #4.

Note: We will shoot a 20 shot Any Rifle/Any Sight club (not sanctioned) match after each 800 point XTC match. This match is free with the payment of the regular match fee. Otherwise, the match is \$10. This match follows the 800 point match directly.

500 point Rifle EIC – 50 shot National Match Course, Table 4.

AUTHORIZED RIFLES:

Rifles authorized for these matches include M16/AR15 Type Service Rifle (Rule 6.1.1), CMP Alternative Rifle (Rule 6.1.2), CMP Match Rifle (Rule 6.1.5), M14 Type Service Rifle (Rule 6.1.3), and M1 Garand Type Service Rifle (Rule 6.1.4).

GENERAL INFORMATION:

No lunch breaks - Bring whatever you require to sustain yourself through the matches. Water will not be available on the range.

Matches will be scored with ShotMarker electronic targets. Competitors are required to bring their own electronic device to interface with the ShotMarker system. Competitors will be required to perform score keeping duties. In the event electronic targets are unavailable, competitors will be required to operate targets. Because electronic targets are prone to causing range alibis, it is suggested that competitors bring enough short-range ammo for a couple of extra strings and additional 600 yard ammo.

AWARDS:

Winners of the Forman Trophy and Cromwell Cup will receive framed prints of the awards and have their names placed on the trophies. Awards for the EIC match will also include achievement pins, overall medals, and of course LEG points. The OKCGC Championship winner will receive a plaque.

Other than that, prizes will be at the discretion of the match director.
