

2025 NATIONAL MID-RANGE PRONE CHAMPIONSHIPS

HOSTED BY THE OKLAHOMA CITY GUN CLUB

Thursday, 5 June through Sunday, 8 June 2025

(Version 1.12)

RANGE LOCATION: 12465 N.E. 234th, Arcadia, OK. Three miles north of Arcadia, OK, on Anderson Rd. At the corner of Anderson Rd. and Sorghum Mill Rd., turn east and proceed approximately 1/2 mile. Go through the gate and take a left at the “T” on the range road, following it to the High-Power Range.

REGISTRATION: Pre-Registration will be accomplished by mailing the completed registration form attached at the end of this bulletin. The registration form must have the appropriate fee included in the form of a check or money order payable to OKC Gun Club. Do NOT send cash! Registration ends 23 May. After this date, registration must be made in person and a \$20.00 late registration fee will be assessed. To receive a refund of your entry fee, a written cancellation request must be received by 23 May. The range capacity is 92 shooters. Competitors are required to sign an Oklahoma City Gun Club release liability before using the range. Each day of competition, competitors are required to check in at the stat office before 0830 hours.

RULES: Current NRA rules will govern. It is the competitor’s responsibility to be familiar with NRA rules and this program.

ShotMarker Settings: This match will be fired utilizing the ShotMarker Electronic Target Scoring System. The electronic target system will be set for no delay, with 1 MOA grid on, and will only show recent shots.

CATEGORIES:

For all matches, categories will be Service Rifle, PALMA Rifle, Match Rifle with Iron Sights, Match Rifle with Optics, and AR-Tactical.

CLASSIFICATION AND SPECIAL AWARDS:

Three (3) entries are required to make a Class and a Special Award group.

In aggregate matches there must be 7 entries for a 2nd place award and 13 for a 3rd place award.

SPECIAL NOTES:

- + Competitor packets will be available for pickup at the Stat Office at 0900 hours on Wednesday, 4 June.
- + A squadded practice will be conducted on Wednesday, 4 June beginning at 1200 hours. The cost for the practice session is \$20.00, paid on the range that morning.
- + There will be a competitor meeting and Shot Marker orientation at 6pm Wed 4 June, at the Clubhouse.
- + There will be five (5) aggregate matches (801-804 & 890) shot over a three (3) day period (5-7 June). Day 1 & morning of Day 2 will be Match Rifle Optic and Iron. Afternoon of day 2 & Day 3 will be Match Rifle iron.
- + Although individual matches will be shot in three (3) days, there will still be daily aggregates aligned on what would be a four (4) day schedule. This will allow for Day 2 having matches for two (2) different sight types.

COMPETITOR RESPONSIBILITIES: Competitors will be required to perform score keeping duties and operate targets if the ShotMarker scoring system is not operational or is unavailable. All matches are currently planned to use the ShotMarker scoring system; please bring a WIFI capable device for scoring and or individual use.

ENTRIES: Open to any individual. If you are an NRA competitor, it is necessary to furnish your NRA member number to enter. Please note that registering on-site may take a while, so please plan accordingly.

Section 23 Rule 3.3.3 Mid-Range AR Tactical will shoot concurrently with matches 805-816. Awards will be issued for daily aggregates 817-820, and a Grand aggregate. AR-Tactical is not in contention for match 800.

AMMUNITION

Ammunition as defined in NRA High Power Rule 3.17 will be allowed in the NRA Mid-Range Championships. Ideally, ammunition should have a velocity of 1,340 fps at the target, to register on the Electronic Target System. The minimum velocity is 1,250 fps at the target.

600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record per firing member. Total block time per team of 89 minutes.
