2026 CMP AR-Tactical Matches

March 8*, April 12, May 3, June 14, July 12, August 9, September 13,
October 11

Range Location: Proceed three miles North of Arcadia, OK, on Anderson Rd. At the corner of Anderson Rd, and Sorghum Mill Rd., turn East and proceed $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Turn left, enter the gate to the property and follow the road to the T, take a left follow the road to the High-Power range.

Street Address: 12465 NE 234th Street, Arcadia, OK 73007

Rules: Current CMP rules will govern. It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with CMP rules and this program.

Registration: Registration will be at the 600-yard line of the High Power Rifle Range, and will open at 12:00, thirty minutes before match begins, closing at 12:30.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 / juniors shoot free

Match Information: Tactical-AR matches have been adopted by the CMP and the NRA due to the popularity of the AR-15 and AR-10 platforms. If a competitor is not "on paper" after two shots, the competitor will stop firing until a match official can assist; with spotting shots and zero adjustments. If a competitor is not on paper within the next four shots, they will be disqualified and required to stop firing.

Course of Fire: The course of fire is "slow fire" prone, meaning the rifle is loaded one round at a time. Shots are displayed on the targets and scored before the next shot is fired, giving competitors the opportunity to make sight adjustments between shots. The match will consist of three strings each of sighting shots followed by 20 shots for record in a time limit of 22 minutes. Unlimited sighters are authorized for the first string of fire while two sighters are authorized for the last two strings.

Firing Position: The position is considered a modification of F-TR class wherein a bipod or backpack is used to support the rifle in the prone position. An unattached rear bag (without "ears") is authorized.

Authorized Rifles and Ammunition:

AR-Tactical Rifle. Rule 5.1.9

Barrel length maximum of 22"

Optics maximum power 16X – may be taped at 16 power if scope is capable of greater magnification.

Caliber - not limited to just .223 Rem or .308 Win, but not greater than .30 caliber.

Projectile must be supersonic and stable at 600 yards.

No muzzle breaks!!

Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) must be used and may be purchased for \$1.00.

Out of Competition: Rifles not complying with the above paragraph may be used but will fire out of competition. Only exceptions are no muzzle breaks and no calibers in excess of .35.

Target: MR-1

Competitor Duties: Competitors will be required to perform scoring duties and may be required to operate targets if the electronic target system is not available. OKCGC members will be asked to secure the pits after the match.

Prizes: Prizes are at the discretion of the Match Director.
