

2026 NATIONAL MID-RANGE PRONE CHAMPIONSHIPS

HOSTED BY THE OKLAHOMA CITY GUN CLUB

Tuesday, 2 June thru Saturday, 6 June 2026

(Version 4)

RANGE LOCATION: 12465 N.E. 234th, Arcadia, OK. Three miles north of Arcadia, OK, on Anderson Rd. At the corner of Anderson Rd. and Sorghum Mill Rd., turn east and proceed approximately 1/2 mile. Go through the gate and take a left at the "T" on the range road, following it to the High-Power Range.

REGISTRATION: Registration will primarily be through Target Score (<https://targetscore.com>) but may also be accomplished through the mail with the registration form found at the end of this bulletin. If mailed, the registration form must have the appropriate fee included in the form of a check or money order payable to OKC Gun Club. Do NOT send cash! Pre-registration ends 23 May. After this date, registration must be made in person. A \$20.00 late registration fee will be assessed. To receive a refund of your entry fee, a written cancellation request must be received or cancellation through Target Score must be made by 23 May. The range capacity is 92 shooters. Competitors are required to sign an Oklahoma City Gun Club release of liability before using the range. Each day of competition, competitors are required to check in at the statistics office before 0830 hours.

RULES: Current NRA rules will govern. It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with NRA rules and this program. Please become familiar with the following NRA High Power Rifle Rules and look for 2026 rule changes:

ShotMarker SETTINGS: This match will be fired utilizing the ShotMarker Electronic Target Scoring System. The electronic target system will be set for no delay, and will only show recent shots.

DISCIPLINES:

For all matches, disciplines will be Service Rifle, Palma Rifle, Match Rifle Iron, Any Rifle Metallic Sight, Match Rifle Optic, Any Rifle Optic Sight, and AR-Tactical.

CLASSIFICATION AND SPECIAL AWARDS:

Three (3) entries are required to make a Class and a Special Award group.

In aggregate matches there must be 7 entries for a 2nd place award and 13 for a 3rd place award.

SPECIAL NOTES:

- + Competitor packets will be available for pickup at the Stat Office at 9:00 AM – 6:00 PM on Monday, 1 June, then 2-6 June, daily 7:30AM – 5:00 PM.
- + A squadded practice will be conducted on Monday, 1 June beginning at 1200 hours. The cost for the practice session is \$20.00, paid on the range that morning.
- + There will be a competitor meeting and Shot Marker orientation at 6pm Monday 1 June, at the Steve Baldwin Clubhouse.
- + There will be no specific discipline requirement to win the Minuteman Trophy (Match 800).
- + AR-Tactical will not compete for the Minuteman Trophy (Match 800) but the winner will be recognized as the NRA AR-Tactical champion (Match 890).

COMPETITOR RESPONSIBILITIES: Competitors will be required to perform score keeping duties and operate targets if the ShotMarker scoring system become inoperable. Additionally, a few of the more experienced competitors will be asked to perform other duties as required such as Block Officer. All competitors must bring a WIFI capable device for scoring and individual use.

ENTRIES: Open to any individual. If you are an NRA competitor, it is necessary to furnish your NRA member number to enter. Please note that registering on-site may take a while, so please plan accordingly.

AMMUNITION

Ammunition as defined in NRA High Power Rule 3.17 will be allowed in the NRA Mid-Range Championships. Ideally, ammunition should have a velocity of 1,340 fps at the target, to register on the Electronic Target System. The minimum velocity is 1,250 fps at the target.

TARGETS

Mid-Range: MR-63, MR-65, and MR-1.

Accommodations on/near OKCGC Property - The Oklahoma City Gun Club offers primitive camping spots as well as RV spots with 30 amp and limited 50 amp electrical and water (\$15 and \$25 per night respectively). To reserve a spot, contact Kent Shomber by text following up with a phone call at (405)205-3689. The club has multiple shower facilities for competitor use.

There are over ten hotels and motels within 10 miles of the range. Lake Arcadia, 5 miles from the range, offers primitive and RV camping.

Entertainment in the area: Arcadia OK, and Edmond OK offer multiple dining options and there are multiple options for entertainment just a short drive from the club to include golf, museums, casinos, horse racing, a zoo, and other points of interest just a internet search away.

Awards Banquet: The awards banquet will be conducted on gun club property at the Steve Baldwin Club House Friday, 5 June. Dinner will be served at 6:00 PM followed by giveaway drawings and awards presentations. Winners are encouraged to wear business attire for photographs.

Daily Burgers and Dogs: At the completion of daily shooting, the OKCGC will provide lunch consisting of hamburgers, dogs, a side or two, and soft drinks for competitors while waiting for the posting of daily results.

Course of Fire

300 YD SF, Target MR-63, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record per firing member. Total block time per team of 97 minutes.
500 YD SF, Target MR-65, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record per firing member. Total block time per team of 97 minutes.
600 YD SF, Target MR-1, Prone, 2 sighting shots, 20 shots for record per firing member. Total block time per team of 97 minutes.

Note: There are no awards or National Records for individual stages.

If fewer than three teams per rifle type (discipline) compete, teams of various disciplines will be combined so that winning teams may be identified. AR-Tactical teams will not be combined with any other discipline.
