 100 yds: 3" on a single hanger

Barricade Setup: Rooftop with peak facing the right. Vertical 55-gal barrel secured with a cradle

Points: 10 points per impact, 120 points possible

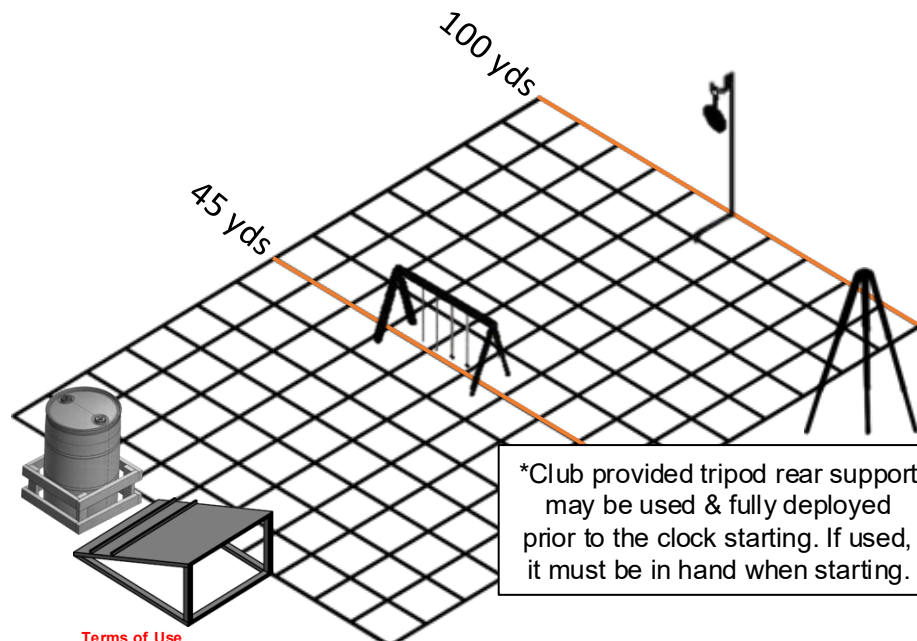
Start Position: Standing, rifle at the high ready with all gear in hand, mag in, action open.

Description: On the start signal, engage the targets as follows:

1. Anywhere in the center ⅓ of the roof slope: KYL - large to small with 1 shot each
2. 55-gal barrel: Far target x2
3. Anywhere in the center ⅓ of the roof slope: KYL - small to large with 1 shot each,
4. 55-gal barrel: Far target x2

Note: The MD may add cleats to the rooftop to prevent the bag from sliding.

Adaptive Suggestion: No change; however, a stool may be used when shooting off the roof top.



*Club provided tripod rear support may be used & fully deployed prior to the clock starting. If used, it must be in hand when starting.

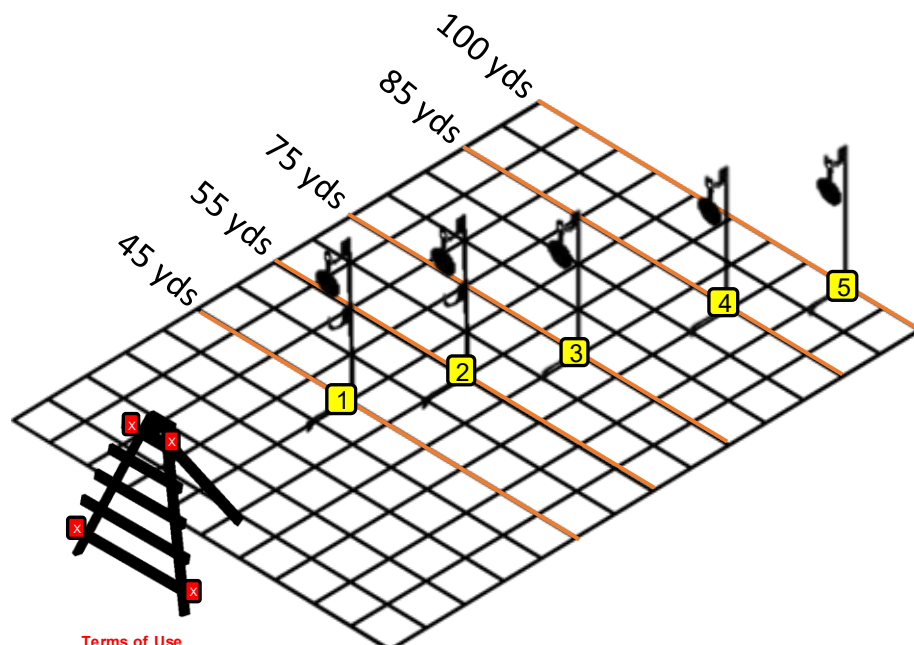

When scoring, always record the total time elapsed in seconds.

Start Position: Standing, rifle at the high ready with all gear in hand, mag in, action open.

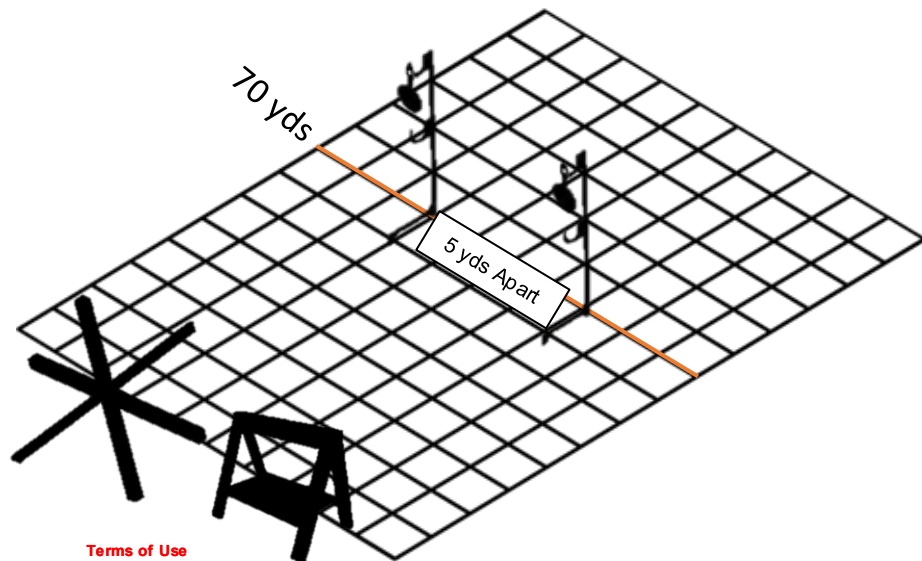
Description: On the start signal, engage the targets, left then right, with 1 shot each from 5 different positions.

The positions available are:

- Each tank trap tip
- tank trap center
- top of sawhorse

Note: All positions must be used and may be shot in any order.

Adaptive Suggestion: Same target engagement. Use each tip, left and right side of the sawhorse. A stool may be used when shooting from the sawhorse.

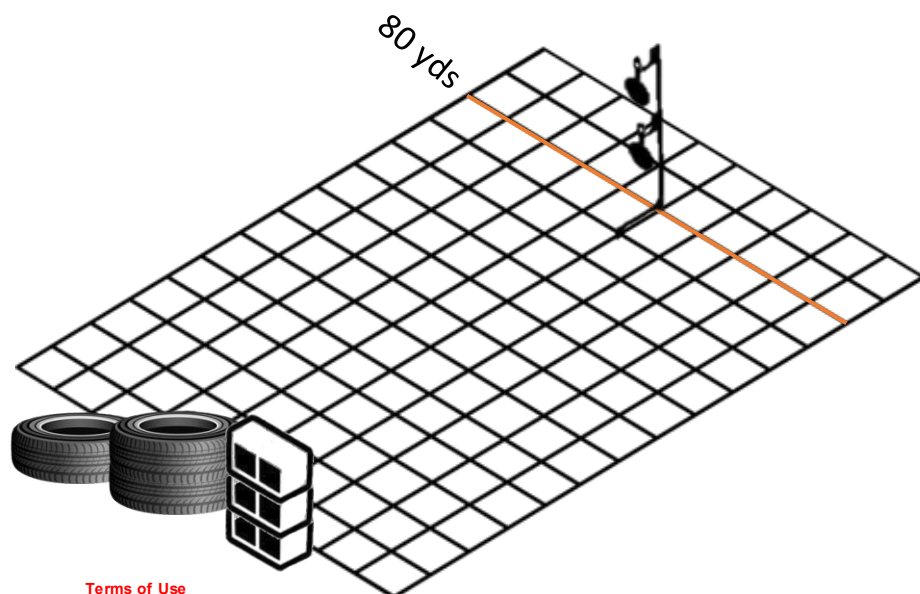

Adaptive Suggestion: Elevate a tire and cinder block on an elevated position. Alternate between the tire and the cinder block.

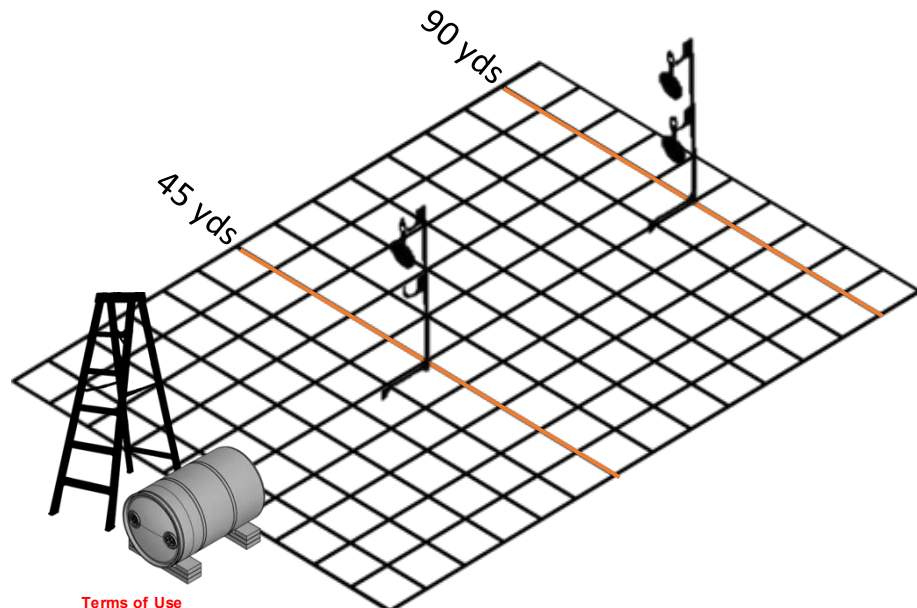

4. Ladder rung: near then far large, one shot each
5. Ladder rung: near then far large, one shot each
6. 55-gal: far small, two shots.

Adaptive Suggestion: Shoot from the highest ladder rung you can safely reach. 55-gal barrel will be vertical.

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Stage 6: Spinning Dinosaurs

Time: 120 sec

Round Count: 10

Ranges and Targets:

Restrictions:

Points: 10 Points per Impact. 100 points possible. 20 bonus points for flipping spinner target.

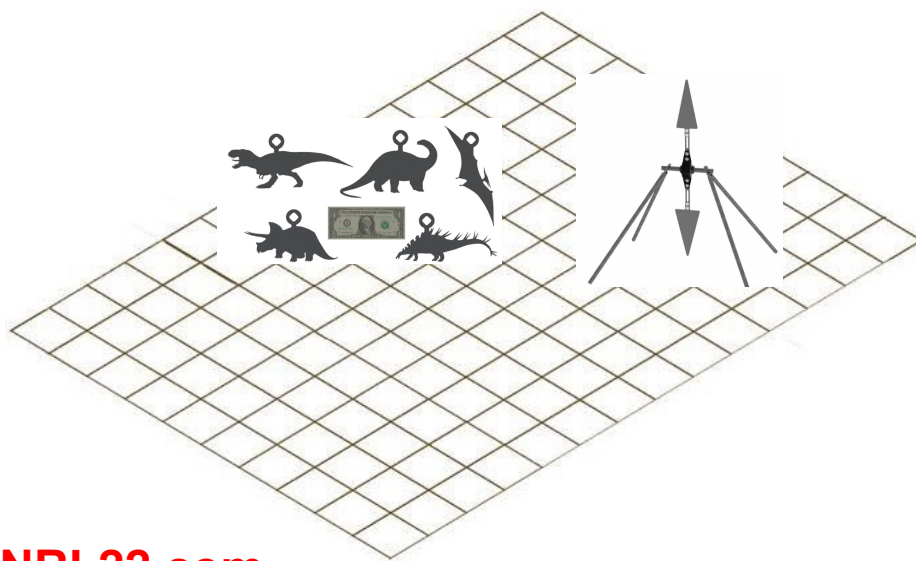
Start Position: Standing, rifle at the high ready with all gear in hand, mag in, action open.

Description:

Take the prone position and engage the dinosaurs from left to right with one shot each. Then engage the spinner target with remaining 5 shots alternating between top and bottom targets in either order.
20 bonus points if the target does spin.

Adaptive Recommendation:

First dinosaurs at 75 yards.
All other targets at 100 yards.





7. 50 yard KYL

Time: 120 Sec

Round Count: 10

Ranges and Targets:

Option 1 – 50 yds:

2", 1-3/4", 1-1/2", 1-1/4", 1", 3/4", 1/2", 1/4" on a KYL

Restrictions: None

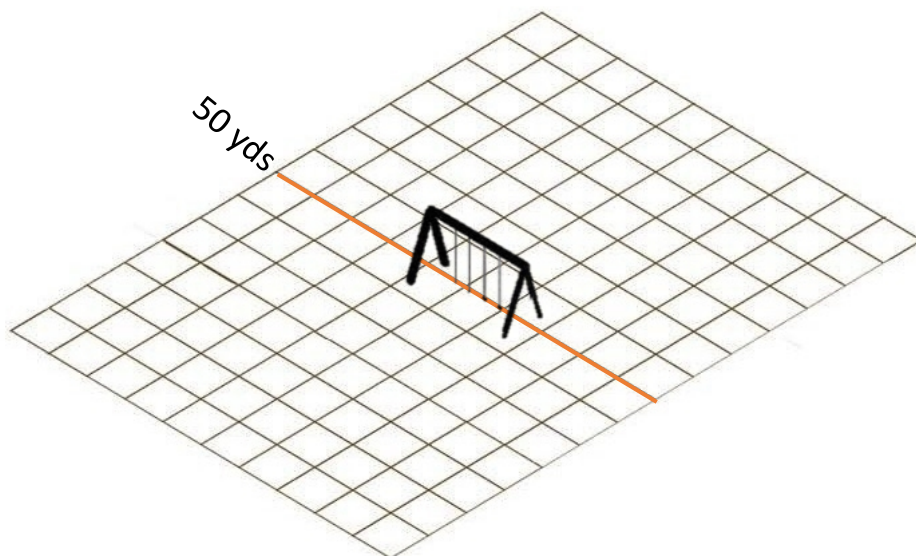
Points: 10 points per impact, 100 points possible

Start Position: Standing, rifle and all gear in hand, mag in, action open

Adaptive Recommendation: Start in position with magazine out and off glass.

Description: On the start signal, take a prone position and engage the KYL target with 1 shot from large to small.

Hit to advance. Continue shooting the smallest target for a total of 10 rounds.





BONUS STAGE:

Stage 8: Simon Says

Time: 120 sec

Round Count: 10

Ranges and Targets:

Restrictions:

Points: 10 Points per Impact. 100 points possible.

Start Position: Standing, rifle at the high ready with all gear in hand, mag in, action open.

Description:

Take the prone position and roll the dice or grab a card. Engage the color indicated and then the center white target. Repeat rolling the dice and engaging both targets until 10 shots have been fired.

Target placed at 100 yards.
