

Tuesday Field & Target Pellet Competition

The Tuesday pellet shooters is a group dedicated to a safe and equal shooting competition. All voices will be heard and considered in choices made by majority vote of this group

This is a democracy: all rules will be voted in by majority vote. All rule changes will be posted for vote for a minimum of 1 week, voted on, then will be in effect for the next match in one week.

General:

- Classes are:
 - Production
 - 10 meter
 - Open
- Scoring: Will be done by group effort
 - 1-3 entries – 1st place awarded
 - 4-5 entries – 2 places awarded
 - 6 + entries - 3 places awarded
- Gun Caliber: .177
- Fee per gun: \$5.00
- Classes can be combined if there are less than 3 entries and lower class competitors want to bump up at shooters discretion
- Competitors can shoot in upper class by paying a separate entry fee, and first shooting in lower class
 - NOTE: competitors **cannot** shoot down and only 1 entry per class
- Sights may be removed for scope installation
- No extra shots in target area/sighters off target area
- Bolts must be open and open bolt indicators should be used while anyone is down range
- Commands will be given for a **cold** (bolts open and open bolt indicators used) and **hot** (commence firing) range
- After a target is removed from the target line it may not be re-posted or re-shot
- Tethered air tanks must be secured to prohibit the danger of falling or damage

Production:

- Guns must be shot as it comes from the factory and no internal modification are allowed
- MSRP not to exceed \$ 750.00
- Match type guns manufactured before 1984 are allowed
- Added external attachments (examples: weights, muzzle brakes, shooting rails or sledge and etc) are allowed
- No custom shop guns are allowed
- Tethering is allowed and may contain external air regulation devices
- Any adjustments that come with the rifle will be allowed

10 meter:

- Guns must be shot as it comes from the factory
- Added external attachments (examples: weights, muzzle brakes, shooting rails or sled and etc) are allowed
- No custom shop guns are allowed
- Tethering is allowed and may contain external air regulation devices

OPEN:

- Any air gun not described under Production or 10 Meter descriptions above
- Guns may contain internal modifications
- Added external attachments and modifications are allowed
- Custom shop guns are allowed
- Tethering is allowed and may contain external air regulation devices
