From the President of the OKCGC

To: Members of the OKCGC

On September 10, 2013 the Board of Directors of the Oklahoma City Gun Club voted unanimously to increase annual membership dues by \$20.00 for all Voting and Associate Members. This increase will take effect beginning January 1, 2014 and will be reflected in your next annual dues statement. It has been seven years since we have had any increase in dues and it is certainly not due to the lack of increase in costs, etc. to operate our facility. As I am sure you have noticed over the years there have been some significant improvements to the club. Many of these improvements have been funded thru increasing the number of members. Recently the Board decided to discontinue increasing the number of members until we have an opportunity to further evaluate our capacity (we don't want to be too crowded during peak usage times). Because we are sensitive to the impact of any increase in dues the Board decided to allocate 100% of this dues increase specifically to range improvements. The first project we have identified is enlarging the Benchrest Range. Because of its increased usage we are going to approximately double the number of firing positions/benches. Additional future range improvements will be forthcoming and will be based on usage and necessity. We continue to have one of the finest shooting facilities in the nation and we will strive to bring improvements to make sure our members have the safest, and most enjoyable shooting experience possible.

Is it High Power or is it Small Bore? 200 yard .22 Matches

The High Power Division had its first 200-yard small bore match on September 22. Competitors fired .22 caliber rifles at the MR52 target, which has an X-ring 1.79 inches in diameter and a 10-ring 3.79 inches in diameter.

The competitors were divided into 3 categories: Military Training Rifle, Unlimited rifle (optics or iron sights) and Tactical Rifle (optics and bipod).

The weather was almost perfect, but most people discovered two things: All .22 ammunition isn't created equally and even a slight breeze will move those little bullets a full scoring ring or more.

The next matches will be October 20th and November 3rd, immediately following the monthly High Power match. The start time will be approximately 1:00 pm.

The rules:

All shooting is done from the prone position and consists of unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record. Competitors will provide pit service for each other.

Shooters are separated into 3 classes:

.22 caliber Training rifle – any U.S.-marked training rifle equipped with iron sights (i.e., Mossberg 44, H&R, Kimber 82G or similar) OR foreign training rifle, fired with or without a sling (no rest or bipod).

Unlimited rifle – any .22 caliber target or varmint rifle (i.e., Anschutz, Martini, Savage, Remington, or similar) equipped with iron or any optical sight fired with or without a sling (no rest or bipod).

.22 Tactical Rifle – any .22 caliber rifle, bolt, semi-auto, or single shot action (i.e., Ruger 10/22, Savage, Remington or similar), equipped with any optical sight and bipod.

There is no cost to participate. A limited number of donated prizes will be available to the winner of each class.

SAFETY

1. Safety is the Number One Concern While Competing in This Match
2. Eye & Ear Protection is Required to Compete in This Match
3. Upon Completion of Your Course of Fire, & Before Leaving Your Shooting Position, Magazines Out, Safety Flags in Chamber. We provide safety flags.
4. No Armor-Piercing Bullets Allowed on the Silhouette Range, regular FMJ OK.
5. Do Not Shoot at Any Silhouette Targets Either During the Match or While Practicing on This Range. Shoot at Swinging Steel Plates Only!!!!
6. Pick Up Your Brass Immediately After Completing Course of Fire. We provide a brass catcher.

MATCH FORMAT

1. This is a 20-Round Match - Five (5) Shots Are Fired on Steel Plates at Each Distance. Club members as well as non-club members may shoot in this match.
2. There Are Two (2) Courses of Fire - SHORT COURSE - 100 Meters, 150 Meters, 200 Meters & 300 Meters - LONG COURSE – 200 Meters, 300 Meters, 385 Meters & 500 Meters – You May Shoot Either or Both – As noted on your scorecard, you may shoot in either the open sight or Scope Category or Both. Be Sure to Check the appropriate Box
3. Entry Fees Are \$10.00 Per Entry – There is no additional charge if you shoot the 20-round speed event providing you shoot both the short range course & long range course. You May Shoot a Re-entry for \$5.00 After Everyone Has Completed Their Course of Fire, But This Score is Not Counted in the Match. Please Mark Re-entry on Your Scorecard
4. You Shoot Off a Bench With Supplied Front Rest or if You Prefer & Your Rifle Is Equipped With a bi-Pod You May Use It. You may also shoot in the prone position on a shooting mat if you like.
5. You Are Allowed a Spotter to Score Your Hits - X=Hit – 0=Miss
6. This is a Elapsed Time Event – Your Time For 20-Rounds Will Be Recorded by a Designated Person With a Very Accurate PACT Timer
7. Please Note; Tie scores Will Be Broken by Shooters Total Elapsed Time Score. Example: Two Shooters Tie with a score of 15x20, Shortest Elapsed Time Determines the Winner. If a Tie Still Remains, a Shoot-off Will Then Take Place Between Competitors. NOTE: You Have a Limit of Four (4) Minutes to Fire Twenty (20) Rounds; Any Late Shot Will Not Count.
8. Sign Your Scorecard After Completing Your Course of Fire, Once You Sign it, You Are Responsible For Any Mistakes.
9. If Your Gun Malfunctions During Course of Fire & You Can't Resolve the Problem Within a Reasonable Amount Time, Safety Flag in Magazine Out!!!
10. Make Sure You Fill Out Your Score-Card Correctly From Top to Bottom
11. This Match is Designed to Have Fun With Your AR, So Please Abide by the Rules Set Forth, So We Can Continue Shooting This Match. We Will Shoot the Last Saturday of Each Month, March thru September, Starting at 9:00 am, you may go to our web site, www.okcgunclub.org & check the event calendar for exact dates.
12. A new event for 2013 will be a 20-round speed event where you will have one minute to fire 20 rounds on steel plates from 100 meters, out to 300 meters; 5 rounds on each plate. There is no charge for this match providing you have paid for two other matches.
