Action Pistol Division

Happy New Year!! Let's see... an outdoor event on January 4th in Oklahoma.... I'd be thinking layers of clothes, gloves, winter coat, thin oil on the gun (or dry lube)... I wouldn't expect a match on a sunny day in short sleeves... but there you go – we're in Oklahoma, where anything can happen.

70 shooters turned out for the January match, including a number of new IPSC shooters. The first squad to finish was about 2:45 with the rest shortly after, and with many folks pitching in to help, the range was clear and cleaned up by about 3:30... not bad at all!

News & Plans:

- We've received a lot of questions about resuming **3-Gun matches**. We believe that the matches will be able to resume later this year. They were postponed due to the work schedules of those involved in running the matches. We hope to announce their return later in 2104.
- **The rifle range on the north end of the range is permanently closed** and will be replaced with one or more pistol bays in the coming months.
- We are exploring other options for providing some steel targets intended for rifle use at longer distances (100 yards and maybe beyond) but at this time no solution has been identified.
- You may or may not have noticed, but a permanent 5-stand facility is in the process of being constructed on the west side of the former black powder range. That range should be up and running as a part of the shotgun division in the coming months. If you haven't ever tried 5-stand you should. It is a lot like sporting clays, but without the long walk. Please welcome the folks who will be driving thru our range on the way to 5-stand who may not have ever seen our style of shooting sports.
- You may have noticed that the pad for the **new building** has been poured. Shortly, the building will be assembled, along with the much-needed shade covers for the north bays. Once the basic structure is in place, we will be holding some work days to finish it out, and get set up and operational. At that time we will primarily be using the northern bays for regular matches.
- Lastly, we are finalizing plans to host an **Oklahoma Sectional** match on the first Saturday in September, in lieu of our normal IPSC match. Details to follow soon.

This is an exciting time for the Oklahoma City Gun Club as we construct many new facilities for all of the shooting sports. All of these range improvements are funded primarily thru the annual dues of our club members as well as thru the match fees paid by competitors like you.

Our next IPSC match will be February 1st. **ALWAYS CHECK THE WEBSITE FOR LAST MINUTE UPDATES & SCORES.**

200 yard .22 Matches

This year the High Power Division conducted three experimental 200-yard small bore matches. The attendees were enthusiastic about continuing the program, so we will continue to offer this match after the High Power matches.

The rules are simple:

All shooting is done from the prone position and consists of unlimited sighting shots and 20 shots for record. Competitors will provide pit service for each other.

Competitors fire from the prone position at the MR52 target, which has an X-ring 1.79 inches in diameter and a 10-ring 3.79 inches in diameter.

Shooters are separated into 3 classes:

.22 caliber Training rifle – any U.S.-marked training rifle equipped with iron sights (i.e., Mossberg 44, H&R, Kimber 82G or similar) OR foreign training rifle, fired with or without a sling (no rest or bipod).

Unlimited rifle – any .22 caliber target or varmint rifle (i.e., Anschutz, Martini, Savage, Remington, or similar) equipped with iron or any optical sight fired with or without a sling (no rest or bipod).

.22 Tactical Rifle – any .22 caliber rifle, bolt, semi-auto, or single shot action (i.e., Ruger 10/22, Savage, Remington or similar), equipped with any optical sight and bipod.

There is no cost to participate. A limited number of donated prizes will be available to the winner of each class.

Come out and have fun!!

Our next matches will be, 23 Feb, 30 Mar, 27 Apr, 27 Jul, 31 Aug, 21 Sep, 26 Oct, and 16 Nov, immediately following the monthly High Power match.

Spring Skeet League

Our spring league for 2014 will start on 25 March. If you are interested in a little friendly competition come on out. Buck Sifford will again be handling the squadding and the sign up, so let him know if you want to shoot. His phone number is 769-7317 and can be reached by email at bucksifford1@cox.net. If you haven't shot with us in the past, come on out, we guarantee you will have a good time. Novice shooter are welcome. We have some excellent shooters who are willing to give advice when asked.

I anticipate at least 120 shooters wanting to participate in the Spring league this year, so with that in mind we have out grown the Tuesday/Thursday format and will be shooting on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday this year. When you sign up please let me know which evening that you want to shoot. I cannot guarantee a particular night but will do the best that I can. I will try to have at least 40 shooters on each night. If 60 shooters want to shoot on Tuesday night, 20 will be asked to move to another night.

Like last year the 2014 Spring League will shoot at 1800 hours (6 pm). We shoot 50 targets (two rounds) per week for 10 weeks for a total of 500 targets. The cost to shoot the league this year will be \$80.00 for club members and \$120.00 for non club members. This covers the cost of 20 rounds of skeet and a trophy at the end of the league. We also try to have a pot luck dinner where we recognize the top shooters. As always this is a duel league, both scratch and handicap. The handicap portion is set up so that a steadily improving shooter has an excellent chance of winning the top spot.

All shooters will be assigned to a team. Each team will consist of 4 or 5 shooters depending upon how many shooter sign up for the league. Each team will compete weekly against another team and will be assigned points depending upon how well they shoot that week. The highest point team at the end of the 10 weeks will be our Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday night champions. The Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday night champions will shoot off the night of our pot luck dinner for the Spring League Championship.

To sign up for the league please send an email to Buck or call him. When signing up please indicate which night you want to shoot. If the night doesn't matter please indicate all three nights, so I can move people around as required. Please give me an email address and a phone number. If you can't email me or call me there will be signup sheets at the club house.
