I would like to become a member of the Oklahoma City Gun Club board of directors. I have been an active gun club member since 2018. I am a Lifetime member of the NRA. I was recently approved as a voting member. Since joining the gun club, I have been active with the training of scouts, the women's fun shoot, and other club activities. I RO for the practice GSSF matches each month and participate with the SASS Wild Bunch. In August of 2020, I was asked to help revitalize the training division. We started many training courses to serve both our members and the community. I developed the curriculum for our entire training program, which has trained over 200 people in the last two years. As a board member, I will continue to advocate for these training courses and look for more training opportunities.

I am an NRA Certified Instructor for pistol, rifle, shotgun, CCW, and metallic reloading. I am also an NRA Chief Range Safety Officer. I am also a Rangemaster Certified Master Instructor for pistols. I have trained over 40 club members to become NRA certified Range Safety Officer. I am semi-retired college professor, having taught full time at Oklahoma State University – Oklahoma City. I also have taught at the University of Phoenix in Oklahoma City. I currently teach part-time at Southern Nazarene University in the Master of Business Administration program. Voting Members,

It has been my privilege to represent you on the Board of Directors for the Oklahoma City Gun Club and I would like to continue doing so. We have such a great facility and membership that it really continues to be a pleasure to serve. I joined the club in the early 1990's where I casually used our facilities before I began competing in USPSA handgun events in 1999. After a year or two competing I became co-match director for the Action Pistol division where I began co-representing the division at the monthly board meetings. When the other co-match director stepped down from the Board of Directors in the early to mid- 2000's I was elected to the Board as his replacement. In 2006 I was appointed by the Board to serve as the clubs Treasurer which I have done continuously since that time. As a Certified Public Accountant for almost 30 years, I believe I have the qualifications to serve as treasurer.

This past year has been a busy time for the club from an infrastructure perspective and I have personally supervised the following club improvements:

- Reconstruction of the Pistol range including a new turning target system
- Relocation and construction of a new Plinking range
- Construction of a second Benchrest range (still in progress)

Although the new benchrest range is still a work in process I believe when completed it will represent more than a 50% increase in Benchrest capacity at distances out to 150 yards. More importantly, as an independently operating range, on weekends when we host regularly scheduled matches one of the ranges should be available for members general use.

We as a club are extremely fortunate to have a large group of people who volunteer their time energy and efforts to serve on the Board, run the different matches and maintain the ranges. You, as voting members, are likely the ones who do the majority that work so please accept my thanks for all your hard work. If you see something that you believe needs to be addressed, please talk with any of the Board members or come to a monthly meeting. All Board meetings are open to club members to attend, and we encourage you to do so. I am not promising we can or will act on every suggestion, but we really do want to hear from you.

I am a current BOD member completing term of a previous BOD member whose chair was vacated. I previously served as a member of the board from 1997 thru 2002 and was the principal founder of the Action Pistol division. When my children became of age to engage in their own interests, I made the decision to step away and devote my time towards their activities. Some on the Board today may remember those baby carriers I brought to many a meeting while my wife was working during tax season!

Currently I reside in Edmond, Oklahoma where my wife of twenty-nine years and myself raised our boys, Joshua and Caleb as well as an adopted foreign exchange student from South Korea, SeungKyu. EDUCATION

I have completed several Continuing Education Seminars in Time Management, Motivational Speaking and People Management. I also possess the knowledge of several programming languages, BASIC, COBOL, Visual Basic, etc., and several database management tools such as MS-Access, FoxPro, etc.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Historically, I also was actively involved with Big Brothers and Big Sisters of America, serving as a volunteer. My wife and I were matched with a young eight-year-old boy and served as his mentor and friend even today. Officially the match was closed when he reached the age of eighteen. However, that little brother became such an integral part of our lives that he is referred to today by my boys as “Uncle Sean”.

I served in many capacities for Big Brothers/Big Sisters of the Greater Oklahoma City area. Shortly after being elected to the Board of Directors I was appointed as Treasurer, responsible for the monitoring of the budget, completion of state and federal Internal Revenue Service year-end tax reports for non-profit agencies, and analysis of income and expenses for daily operations. When first appointed to the position, the annual budget was approximately \$225,000. Before my involvement on the BOD, the agency served approximately 50 children (matches) at a somewhat high average cost per match. Upon completion of my involvement with the agency, more than 400 children were being served at an average cost that resulted in an increase in efficiency of over 400%.

For my efforts and accomplishments both on the Board of Directors and as a Big Brother, I was recognized by the Points of Light Foundation & Volunteer Center National Network. This recognition of achievement was also acknowledged by President George W. Bush, President George H. Bush, United States Senators from Oklahoma Don Nickles and James M. Inhofe, and Oklahoma Governor Frank Keating. I am the only director of the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Greater Oklahoma City agency to ever receive this national recognition and only one of a few from the State of Oklahoma to receive such an honor.

INTEREST / HOBBIES

While I never really left the sport or our club, my opportunities for competition were greatly diminished while I was involved with my son’s activities. Today I am once again actively involved with the action pistol division. I am an avid outdoorsman enjoying fishing, hunting, and hiking. I am a lifetime hunting and fishing license holder in the state of Oklahoma. I also enjoy snow skiing with my family. I am a lifetime member of the NRA as well as a lifetime member of the United States Practical Shooting Association where I also hold a current Range Officers certification.

SUMMARY

I believe my experience and abilities make me a valuable asset to any group or organization interested in results-oriented achievement. My tenure in the business world engaged with private equity companies as well as publicly traded companies over the last thirty years, demonstrates commitment to those organizations and their mission of providing the highest quality services and products utilizing the most cost-efficient means. The purpose of this letter is to notify the Board I will be seeking re-election of my board position, which terminates May 2022.

I have been a member of the Oklahoma City Gun Club ("OKCGC") for 25 years. Approximately 23 years ago I was approached about starting some type of women's program and in December of 1999, I was elected to serve as the Chairman of the first ever Women's Division of the OKCGC. In 2000, I wrote and received a grant from the National Rifle Association ("NRA") to host a women's instructional shooting clinic ("Women's Fun Shoot") and submitted a separate grant to train 10 women to be NRA certified firearms instructors. **Since that time, I have continued to coordinate this event and the 23rd Annual Women's Fun Shoot will be held September 10, 2022.** With the time and dedication of so many OKCGC members, **this event has been the largest and most successful women's shooting clinic in the United States since its inception.** This event has introduced thousands of women and youth to the shooting sports.

In addition to serving as the Women's Division Chairman, I have served as an officer since 2001 and currently hold the position of President for the past 10+ years. I also serve as the Co-Chairman for the Training Division as it pertains to Boy Scout Merit Badge Certifications and the 5-Stand Division Chairman.

In 2005, I was awarded the first Marion P. Haimner Women of Distinction Award from the NRA. It was an extremely proud moment for me and I accepted the award on behalf of the OKCGC, as I felt had it not been for the OKCGC and all those members who had volunteered their Saturday every September for the past 22 years, it would not have been possible.

In October 2018, I was invited to serve on the NRA Women's Leadership Forum at NRA headquarters in Virginia. Along with four other women from across the United States, I not only represented women shooters at large, but also was able to consult on the operations/challenges of gun clubs across the country.

As a board member, and in particular as President, it is my belief one of my duties is to be a spokesperson and liaison to the community. I think it is vital to remember there is a large and active sector of the population **that have no use whatsoever for the shooting sports, gun clubs and/or preserving our Second Amendment rights.** This is in the forefront more so now than ever. With this in mind, I have worked diligently and methodically to make a connection with the local community and Oklahoma Legislature by showing that OKCGC serves a vital role in this regard. Our existence could be challenged at any time and building a **personal relationship with the community is critical to help ensure our continued growth and existence.** I feel during my term as a board member I have accomplished this by making opportunities available and changing attitudes as they relate to shooting sports and more importantly, the OKCGC. Some of the events I have coordinated and/or been involved with during my term are listed below:



An amendment to club bylaws permitting changes to club by-laws, range access and other issues by a simple majority vote of the voting members by way of special referendums voted upon annually.

I hope I will have the privilege of representing all of our club members.


FOUR STATE TWO MAN TEAM MATCH

Ten OKCGC members made the drive to eastern Texas representing Oklahoma and our esteemed gun club at the Four State Two Man Team Match, held in Carthage Texas at the Panola County Gun Club. This benefit match conducted on March 4th and 5th, in its fourth year, has completely paid off the club's land acquisition loan following the club losing its lease, virtually saving the club from its peril. We don't know how good we have it being OKCGC members, not having to worry about such things!!

Two of our teams consisted of five members of The U.S. National Rifle Team, three of which being members of the U.S. international rifle team: The 2024 U.S. Palma team. One member of the group was a past U.S. international F-Class team captain. Talk about a tough bunch of shooters to throw at the competition! When the shooting was done, Oklahoma was certainly on top, by a LARGE margin!!

"USNRT Morris", consisting of Pat Morris coaching and firing members Curt Bohlman and Kent Shomber took first place overall "Sling Category", while "USNRT Gold Oklahoma", consisting of Tanner Burrows and Bill Meade took second overall, and first place "Palma Category". Here's the clincher: Each of these two teams lost only 3 points over the course of the two-day competition and a possible 2000 points! The match was decided by X-count wherein the winning team lead by only 4 Xs!! Final scores were 1997-136x and 1997.132x respectively: THAT'S REALLY TIGHT!!! The next closest team was 20 points behind us. Interestingly USNRT Morris won last year at this match as well, also dropping only three points!

Benchrest Construction Update & Related Silhouette Range Closures

While in the process of clearing the trees to make room for the expansion of the benchrest range to the west (where the old plinking range is/was) we have discovered that the work area is significantly exposed relative to the silhouette range. Because we place the safety of our members and the public above all else, we have decided we need to close the silhouette range Monday thru Friday until the new berms have been constructed and the work area is adequately protected. Please know that we do not close ranges unnecessarily and we will be making every effort to get those ranges open as soon as we can do so safely.

Accordingly, we have posted the Silhouette range as closed during the week (Monday thru Friday) effective Monday January 3, 2022 thru the end of February. As is the case with the benchrest range, the Silhouette range will be open every weekend during construction for use by members.

During the construction please **DO NOT INTERRUPT THE CONTRACTOR** and absolutely do not exit your vehicle while equipment is being operated. The operator does not have good visibility while working in the equipment and a person walking in the work area can be extremely dangerous. Our plan is to expand the benchrest range to the west by constructing an independently operating range with targets out to 100 yards. Depending on the topography we might be able to get a little longer distance than 100, but at this point we do not anticipate going much beyond that. Most of the users of the benchrest range only shoot targets at 100 yards or less and by increasing the number of 100-yard shooting positions we can alleviate some of the congestion at the benchrest range especially on weekends.

OKC Gun Club Construction Update

In addition to the new plinking range we are finishing up our repairs to the benchrest range and we will soon begin the construction of an additional benchrest range where the old plinking range was located. We will make any needed enhancements to the east and west berms, remove the old plinking targets and cover and push the rear berm back to 100 yards, and install new shooting benches. This new benchrest range will function as a separate range and operate independently from the existing range. This means when we have a competitive event at one range the other range could still be open for members to use. In addition, we expect we can get an approximate 50% increase in capacity out to 100 yards. We find the greatest % of people really don't shoot that much past 100 yards. By adding more 100-yard shooting positions we can help alleviate some of the congestion on our most heavily used range. Please be patient with us during the construction process. Because of the usage of heavy equipment, we will be forced to close the range during the week (M-F) while construction is underway, and it could take 2-3 months depending on weather. The range should always be available on weekends. We will be making every effort to open the existing benchrest range as soon as we can and once the berm between the two ranges is adequate to protect the operator, we may be able to open benchrest during the week before construction is completed. It is VERY IMPORTANT that you do not exit your vehicle for any reason while construction activities are underway. The operator has limited visibility and we do not want anyone injured. You are welcome to observe the work, just do it from the parking lot and stay out of the operator's way. Also please do not stop him to ask questions.
