



Introduction To: "Air Rifle Indoor Precision BR Matches"

This indoor shooting competition takes place in the OKC Gun Club Main Club House, with year-round air conditioning. Our competition is shooting our own air guns from a bench, using a shooting platform or a 2-piece rest to steady our rifle. We do not have teams. Our scores are scored individually. Currently, we have 1 class, and the rifles are "open class" or "unlimited class". The competitors use 36 X power scopes or even more powerful scopes. The phrase "Bring your Best to do your Best" is what we are all about. The distance we shoot is 17 meters, which is the same distance the silhouette shooters shoot in the main club house. We supply targets that are designed to be difficult, and we also charge a weekly entry fee to offset the cost of the .999 pure silver coins that we give as prizes each week. At the present, we have only 1 class of rifles, but we will offer a 2nd level of rifles if the supply & demand warrants.

Monday match time includes a practice time from 7:00 AM to 8:00 AM and then from about 8:15 to 11:00 AM is for the match and awards time.

In general, the pellet cost is about 0.04 per pellet, and the practice and entire match usually consists of 100 - 150 total shots.

OKC Gun Club Members and guests are welcome to come, observe, and participate in any of our Monday Matches.

The match shooting time starts at 9am as all are welcomed to see the competitors in action. There are some basic curtesy rules for observing that need to be followed while watching. Also, Club Members who wish to shoot are welcomed.

As stated, this is a "qualifying event" for those wishing to shoot at the State Championship but any 3D shooter can participate. Again, there are some specific rules to be followed for those participants. The cost for Club Members is \$15.

In addition to the match, a fun shoot will take place following the event. Last, but not least, a great food truck will be available from 7am to 2pm serving breakfast in the morning and great lunches throughout the day.


