I would appreciate your vote, as I would be honored to serve another term as a board member of the Oklahoma City Gun Club.

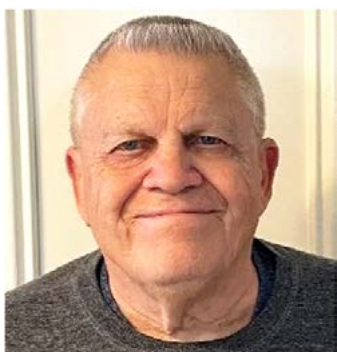

## Firearms Malfunction in Self-Defense Saturday, May 9, 9 am – 12 pm Training Building/Pistol Range

This is a handgun malfunction clearing class focusing on how to quickly clear and fix a firearm stoppage (malfunction) in emergency self-defense and high-pressure situation. The class will have both classroom and live fire training at the range. The classroom will teach Causes for Malfunctions, Instant Recognition, Immediate/Emergency Action Drills for all levels of malfunctions, and Preventions of Malfunctions. Afterwards, the class will move to the range for live fire malfunction drills and practice. This is not a beginner class. To attend this training class, you MUST have previously completed one of the following OKCGC classes: The OKCGC Basic Handgun class, the Ladies Pistol League Basic class, the SDA Refresher class, or similar documented OKCGC or NRA course. ## Glock Courses Coming to OKCGC in May

The OKC Gun Club Training Division is hosting two Glock training courses this coming May 19-21 at the gun club. These courses are open to Active/Retired Law Enforcement or Military, Private Security, Glock Stocking Dealer/Range Program Employee, or current GSSF member. The Low Profile Carry course has the same eligibility requirements as the Armorers course and adds or students who possess a current Concealed Carry Permit (SDA) from your state of residence.

The second course is the Glock Low Profile Carry course. This 16-hour course increases your knowledge and skills with concealed carry techniques for everyday carrying. This is not an introductory course. This course is designed for public safety professionals, military personnel, and law-abiding citizens who want to improve their skills while carrying a concealed Glock pistol. This course is a dynamic shooting course that requires the ability to stand for long periods of time, present your pistol from a concealed holster, shoot on the move, move into and recover quickly from the kneeling and prone positions. A certificate is issued upon completion and may be eligible for CLEET continuing education credit. The cost is \$500 per student.

## Shotgun Division

The Shotgun Division at Oklahoma City Gun Club provides members with dedicated facilities and organized programs for skeet and trap shooting. The division features multiple skeet fields, combination skeet/trap fields, and supporting clubhouse amenities designed to serve shooters of all experience levels.

Throughout the year, the Shotgun Division offers a variety of structured activities and learning opportunities, including Beginner Skeet lessons, Trap League, Skeet League, and instructional clinics. The club also hosts youth skeet camps focused on introducing and developing young shooters, as well as adult skeet camps designed to help participants build skills and confidence. In addition, the division regularly hosts Registered Skeet events for members interested in competitive shooting as well as several collegiate teams and youth groups such as 4-H and FFA.

Open Shotgun shooting is typically available on Saturdays and Sundays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., providing members an opportunity to shoot under supervision during scheduled weekend hours. Times and availability may vary due to events or weather, so members should always check the online club calendar before planning a visit.

For members seeking greater flexibility, the Shotgun Extended Access (SEA) program allows qualified participants to access skeet and trap fields outside of normal supervised hours. After completing required safety training and orientation, SEA members may use designated fields independently, providing additional opportunities to practice and shoot on their own schedules. SEA training is normally offered in February and September.

Schedules and offerings change throughout the year, so members should always check the online club calendar for the most current information.


