

Member badges for 2024 will be mailed mid January 2024.





2024 Spring Skeet League

Our spring league for 2024 will start on Tuesday, March 19th and Thursday, March 21st. Robert Buswell will be handling sign-up and league operation. If you haven't shot with us in the past, come on out, we guarantee you will have a good time. New shooters are welcome; this league is designed for our members to meet each other and make new friends. While it is competitive, the main objective is to have fun!

The 2024 Spring League will shoot at 6:00 PM. We shoot 50 targets (two rounds) per week for 10 weeks for a total of 500 targets. The total cost to shoot the league this year will be \$130. This covers 20 rounds of skeet, hotdogs each night, assorted meats for a pot luck awards dinner, and medallions for the recognition of top shooters and teams.

Sign-up will be located on the north porch of the large shotgun division clubhouse. Please sign-up by providing your name, email address, and phone number. We anticipate at least 100 shooters wanting to participate in the spring league this year... sign-up promptly! We will start by filling team slots for Tuesday and Thursday evenings and will only expand into Wednesday evening if there is sufficient participation to justify.

FEES & TOKENS: Tuesday shooters will need to be at the clubhouse on March 12th from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM to pay league fees and receive tokens. Thursday shooters will need to be at the clubhouse on March 14th, same time period, same purpose.

- You are limited to shooting lead shot and nothing larger than $7\frac{1}{2}$ shot.

The Value of a Workday

As forecasted temperatures began to decline, I started trying to chip away at the High Power Division director's resolve, urging him to reschedule the work day that was to take place the upcoming weekend. My reasoning was simple: Of the twenty something members who had volunteered to work, the majority were going to cancel, and there will be more time spent standing around a burn barrel trying to keep warm than working. The day was to start out in the low double digits and move slowly to a high in the upper twenties. It was going to be miserable – we would have to schedule another workday anyway to get the work done that we had planned.

Five-stand was canceled, then the Shotgun Honors training that weekend was canceled, but Director Kent Shomber was not deterred.

The thermometer on my truck read 12 degrees when I pulled through the main gate, chainsaw and bladed weed-eater in my truck's bed, Carhartts in the back seat. This was going to be a miserable wasted day.

When I made the corner and approached the High Power club house, my predictions began to play out. There were only a few vehicles parked around. I walked into the club house and there was only a hand full of guys, most of whom I'd never seen before, and a couple of club officials, not many conversations. This was going to suck. I let the director know I'd be working in the target pit today, cutting the saplings, green brier, and sumac off the 600yd impact berm. I begrudgingly made my way down range and got to work.

30 minutes later I trudged back to my tailgate for some more two cycle fuel, and you imagine my surprise at the sight of fifteen or more trucks between the 400 and 500 yard lines, and workers, with the urgency of ants, cutting trees, and dragging brush. Were they having a good time?! I went back to my work in the pit, somewhat confused.

In another couple of hours my work in the pit was nearing its end and five or so of the volunteers showed up to cheerfully drag away all the cut brush I had created. Are you kidding me? Cheerful? It may have been 22 degrees out!

We were all but done when someone walked into the pit and announced it was time for lunch. Instead of everyone dropping want they were doing for the cook's reprieve, they stayed at it for another fifteen minutes, completing the job. What was motivating these lunatics?!

After a hot bowl of some of the best deer chili I had ever eaten and some pleasant conversation with some new friends in the warmth of the club house, we all went back to work conquering a tree line. Without exception everyone was engaged, smiles on faces, pulling in the same direction to get the job done. There was talk of shooting, hunting, family, and everybody there was making new friends. I was being taught a lesson I had long forgotten: that adversity creates bonds that far outlast hardships.

As workday cards were being signed, and goodbyes were being said, it struck me that the workdays create friendships, something worth far more than an \$80 dues credit, and perhaps the most valuable benefit of being a part of the OKC Gun Club.

The GSSF match was not cancelled but only one shooter came out, so they just practiced. Steel Challenge and ICORE both cancelled. Two days before the Steel Challenge match, only 3 shooters had registered which is highly unusual, suggesting that shooters had already decided to sit this one out anyway. Hopefully February will be better.

The Action Pistol Division held their first Bowling Pin Shootout on December 30th. It was a huge success with 66 guns shot by 41 competitors in total. \$1300 in cash prizes were awarded by overall finish within categories including random draws. Our next Bowling Pin Shoot-Out will be March 30th, 2024. Stay tuned for more information as the date approaches.
