5 Stand Summer League

The 5 Stand Range held its inaugural league in June. A total of 36 shooters, ranging from seasoned to newcomers in the sport, participated to test and increase their skills. Shooters were assigned to squads with specific shooting times starting at 4:30 pm and ending just before sunset each Monday. Shooters participated in two rounds with 25 targets each week, totaling 250 for the league. The challenge increased each week with varied setups and target directions, including normal, midi and rabbit targets.

After four of the five weeks of the league, two shooters have achieved a perfect score of 25. The final results will be posted in next month's edition of The Primer.

With this being the inaugural 5-Stand league, we appreciated the patience with some growing pains and adjustments with machines at times.

We are planning another league opportunity in August to be held on Mondays and Tuesdays. If you are interested, please be on the lookout for the email. We look forward to welcoming even more participants in the upcoming league and hope to see returning faces as well as new competitors.



Mid-Range High Power Championships at OKCGC

High Power prone rifle shooters from 14 states and one other country descended on the Oklahoma City Gun Club last month seeking a national title. It was the US Mid-Range Championship's Minute Man Trophy they sought. Some of central Oklahoma's coolest June temperatures and lightest winds were sure to make this match enjoyable and memorable for those in attendance.

Mid-Range High Power Rifle is a discipline shot from the prone position with only the support of a sling and shooting jacket, no rests of any kind. Rifles allowed must be less than 35 caliber and may not have muzzle breaks. Some shooters prefer modern optics, but others stick with open sights.

The matches drew top competitors from throughout the country, perhaps the most accomplished being retired Army Marksmanship Unit Sergeant First Class Brandon Green. In the past several years, Green has won every NRA Long Range trophy there is, most multiple times, but had yet to win the Mid-Range Minute Man. To make that happen, he brought a Nesika bolt action rifle with optics chambered in 6GT and shot Berger 109gr Hybrids.

The course of fire was four 600 point aggregates shot over a 3 day period: two aggregates of 300, 500, and 600yd matches, and two aggregates of 3x600yd matches for a total of 2400 points. Here's how it shook out:

After the first 600-point aggregate, one point separated ten of our competitors, to no one's surprise Brandon Green in the lead, posting a perfect 600-52x. The second aggregate narrowed the field of leaders to only five competitors just one or two points down, but Green had some problems, dropping four points to most of the leader's one. By the end of the third aggregate, it was apparent that OKCGC's own Tanner Burrows was there to win, shooting a perfect 600-44x, the only "clean" that day, but Green held his own with a 599-47x – the match clearly wasn't over. In the final day of shooting Burrows posted his lowest aggregate of the match, a 598-42x, but Green's 600-49x wasn't enough to catch him. Green's Grand aggregate score of 2395-189x was second to Burrows' 2396-172x, with Chuck Rowe in third with a 2395-143x.

Tanner Burrows, who started shooting competitively only six years ago, had already shot on the US Palma Team in 2024, and training insatiably, has established himself as a lead competitor. He shot a TUBB ATR rifle, with open sights, sporting a Bartlein barrel chambered in 6BRA.

Though Green did not achieve his main goal, he did topple 3 national records, all Military Veteran records: one for a single 300yd match, a 200-19x; one for an aggregate match, a 600-52xm and then the Grand Aggerate, with his 2396-189x.

Preparing for SASS National Championships

The Cowboy Action division started working on the 2025 Single Action Shooting Society (SASS) National Championships of Cowboy Action and Wild Bunch Shooting which will be held October 4-11. We already have 740 registered shooters and over 100 campers, making it the largest match our club hosts and the largest Cowboy Action match in the country. Now it is time to start on the range preparations. There are several work-day opportunities and membr help is greatly appreciated.

WORK-DAY: Saturday, July 19

We have scheduled a work-day on the cowboy range 8:00 am-2:00 pm, lunch and drinks are provided. We will be doing target work, tearing down a small building and installing walls on another prop along with general clean-up and weed-eating.

WORK-DAY: Saturday, Sept. 27

Another work-day is scheduled for Sept, 27. We will cleaning up the Cowboy, Action Pistol, 5-Stand, Smallbore and Airgun ranges— mowing, weed-eating, trimming trees, gathering all trash/hulls/brass in bays and small repair projects. Again, we will work from 8:00 a.m. to approx. 2:00 p.m., lunch and drinks provided. You may call me directly if you have questions, J.R. Hile 405-409-9442.

WORK-DAYS: Sept. 29-30

Our last prep for the match will be Sept. 29-30 when we'll be setting targets and installing props.

WORK-DAYS: Oct. 2-4

Finally, we'll need help with the actual running of the match, our core group of 40 will pre-shoot the match on Oct. 2-4, we'll need a couple of people to be on the range and help with RVs coming in while we shoot.

WORK-DAY: Tuesday, Oct. 7

For the actual match on October 7 through 11 we'll need help with parking and trash. We shoot warm-ups all day Tuesday and Wednesday and three separate flights of 240 people each Thursday – Saturday, so even if you can just help for a few hours at a time, it's a big help.

Burrows' victory was sweetened with a national record as well. In registered competition, when a competitor completes a string of fire shooting all X's, all center bullseyes, he continues to fire until something another than an X is recorded. After Burrows' twentieth X in a row he continued firing, shooting five more X's before he leaked one out into the 10 ring, this was at 600yds. His score for the statistics office was a 200-20x, but his score for the record books was a 200-20x +5. Before this the closest score ever recorded in a registered match was a 200-20x +2. Because he was shooting open or "Iron" sights he broke both the "Iron Sights" record and the "Any Sight" (Optics) record.

But we weren't done with records for the week. The day following the individual matches, five mid-range teams locked horns to decide the 2025 championship team. Dominating the team match was USNRT Rowe, led by Chuck Rowe as Captain and Coach, and with shooters Kim Rowe, Joe Wawrzaszek, Larry Sollars, and Johnathon O'Neal. All shooters shot in the Any Rifle/Any Sight category. The course of fire was 20 shots for record at the 300, 500, and 600 yard lines. When the last round was downrange, USNRT Rowe had dropped only one point for a 2399-179x, a new national record.

The first NRA National match held at the OKCGC was an overwhelming success. It brought top shooters together with their wealth of knowledge, and provided plenty of time to discuss the finer points of the sport with those less accomplished. Competitors left knowing that the staff of just under 50 club volunteers ran a great match and that the facility was outstanding. Many of them have already vowed to return next year perhaps with a friend or two for another run at the Minute Man Trophy.

2025 Summer Skeet League Sign-Up

The sign-up sheet will be located outside of the north door to the large shotgun clubhouse. This year we are offering league on Tuesday and Thursday nights!

League shooting will start on Tuesday, July 8th at 6:00 PM and Thursday, July 10th. If you haven't shot with us in the past, come on out, we guarantee you will have a good time. New shooters are welcome, there is always someone willing to help or give advice. This league is designed for folks to meet each other and make new friends. While it is competitive, the main objective is to have fun!

The 2025 Summer League will shoot two rounds per week for 10 weeks for a total of 500 targets. Cost to shoot the league this year will be \$130. This covers 20 rounds of skeet, hotdogs each night, assorted meats for a pot luck dinner, and awards for the top shooters and teams.

FEES & TOKENS: Those who have signed-up to shoot will need to be at the large shotgun clubhouse on Tuesday, July 1st from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM to exchange fees for tokens/cards.

REMEMBER...

• Do not sign-up for the league if you can't shoot on your squad's designated night. An aspect of shooting in skeet league is experiencing team camaraderie... so shoot with your team!

- Everyone should show-up for league by 6 PM... members of one team are supposed to pull and score for the other team and vice versa... if you're on time, you're late!
- \bullet You are limited to shooting only lead shot and nothing larger than $7\frac{1}{2}$ shot.
- You are allowed to shoot make-up rounds but try and have them shot in a few weeks, if nothing is turned in when scoring is finalized, then dog scores will be entered.
- You are encouraged to pre-shoot rounds for planned absences.
- Score sheets for make-up rounds and pre-shot rounds should be noted and dated as such and pinned to the bulletin board where weekly scores are posted.




