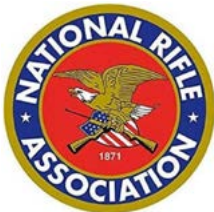
May 2026 Construction Update

In January the Board approved funding to continue modernizing the berms on the Action Shooting ranges—these are the six north most bays on Hiwasse Road north of the Shotgun facility. Our target for 2026 was to complete the remaining northern bays. I am writing this in mid-April, and I am somewhat confident the construction will be completed by the time this article is published. If true, this will complete the rear impact berm project which began with the muzzleloading berm in 2023, and the cowboy action berm in 2024 and 2025. We appreciate your patience during the construction and the associated range closures.

Members are reminded that on all ranges bullets must impact the berms and never the floor of the range. When using the cowboy and action shooting bays please place targets at the bottom of the berms. If you want to shoot the targets from a closer position, just go downrange. You are not required to shoot from the covered portion (for those bays with covers). This ensures that all bullets impact the berms.

Please be patient and as always be sure to check the club calendar before you come to the facility for scheduled events as well as construction closures. We have a lot going on at the club, and we know it is frustrating to arrive and find out there are construction closures, workday projects, or other scheduled activities.

Pistols Malfunction in Self-Defense

This is a handgun malfunction clearing class focusing on how to quickly clear and fix a firearm stoppage (malfunction) in emergency self-defense and high-pressure situation. The class will have both classroom and live fire training at the range. The classroom will teach Causes for Malfunctions, Instant Recognition, Immediate/Emergency Action Drills for all levels of malfunctions, and Preventions of Malfunctions. 
