My name is J.R. Hile and I have been a OKC Gun Club member for more years than I can remember. In 2010, I was elected by the Oklahoma Territorial Marshals to be chairman of the Cowboy Division. Not long after that I was fortunate to be elected to the Board of Trustees for the Oklahoma City Gun Club.

During that time, thanks to the efforts of our members and board, our club has grown tremendously, and our facilities have improved dramatically.

When I became involved with the Cowboy Division, we were sharing our shooting area with Action Pistol. Since that time, the Action Pistol Division has constructed six shooting bays and a new clubhouse with showers and indoor restrooms.

The shooting area that was formerly used solely by the Muzzle Loader Division has been improved and expanded and is now a 100-yard benchrest area and home to numerous other divisions and is used much more efficiently than ever before.

Also, while staying on the east side of the club, we now have a five-stand shotgun area that is used extensively by leagues and other club members.

Not to be outdone, the rest of the club has also seen significant growth and improvement. A recently constructed 1000-yard range is part of the Highpower Division.

The club also built a new state-of-the-art pistol facility and continues to improve it as the use grows.

By adding another bench-rest area and relocating the plinking range, the board has continued to evaluate and make changes to accommodate the needs of our members.

During this time, we constructed a Pavilion that is available to our members and families and guests free of charge.

The number and size of the improvements made at the OKC-Gun Club over the past decade are astounding. Again, this was all accomplished with the help of our members and board. We should all be very proud of being members of what I believe, the best gun club in the world. Those of us who travel for competitions and visit clubs around the U.S. know that what I say is true.

I encourage every member to get involved with a division and enjoy the benefits of your membership.

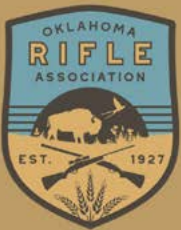

We will provide bows and arrows, but encourage all to bring archery equipment if you have it. There is no charge for this event and both club members and the general public are invited. We support Food for Families in need, and ask that those participating bring a canned food of some kind.

August 2026 Construction Update

The berm work on the northern 6 Action Shooting/Cowboy bays is still in progress awaiting the contractor to complete another project he began when his equipment he was using for our project broke down. We continue to believe there are only about 10 days of work remaining before he is complete.

In addition to the berm project, you will soon see a new electric gate being installed at the Cowboy entrance. Concrete work is scheduled for July 23-24 and during this time members may need to use the north entrance along Hiwassee Road. The project is being funded by a combination of a generous donation from a club member (who wishes to remain anonymous), funds from the divisions that use that gate (primarily action pistol and the cowboy division), and funds from the main club. I have designed the gate to be identical to the main gate, and it will allow large vehicles to be fully off

Hiwassee road before stopping to enter a code. The gate controller will also be capable of enhanced functionality that we can use to test things such as temporary gate codes, and possibly member specific RFID badges.

Please be patient and as always be sure to check the club calendar for scheduled events, as well as construction closures before you come to the facility. We have a lot going on at the club, and we know it is frustrating to arrive and find out there are construction closures, workday projects, or other scheduled activities.

We appreciate your patience during the construction and the associated range closures.

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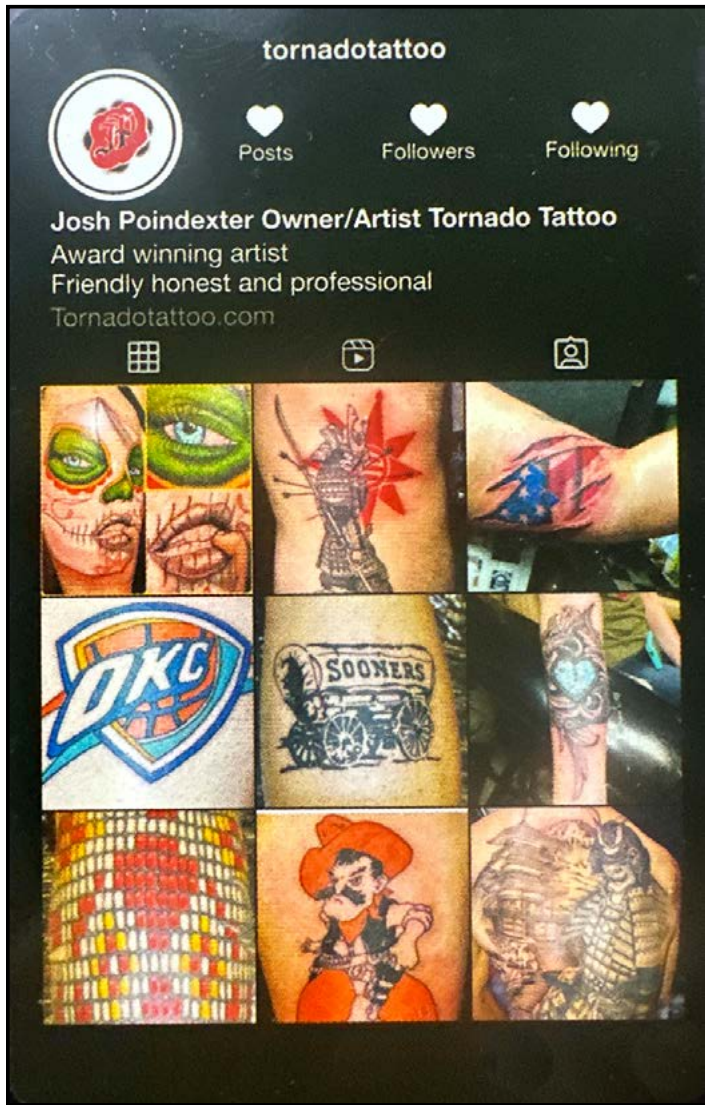
