OKC Gun Club Action Shooting Range Closures 2026 Construction Update

Please be aware that on January 7, 2026, the Board approved funding to continue the berm modernization efforts on the Action Shooting ranges. These are the ranges located on Hiwassee Road

north of the Shotgun facility consisting of 6 Action Shooting bays on the far north end.

Last year we completed reconstructing the rear impact berms on the northern portion of the Cowboy bays. Because of the scale of the project, this is a multi-year effort and our goal for 2026 is to complete the remainder of the northern bays this year.

The contractor will be working inside the bays then raising the berms above their existing height. It will be necessary to close all 6 north Action Shooting bays Monday through Friday while construction is taking place, however all bays should be available on the weekends. During the week there should be bays available for members to use (especially the south bays where the work has already been completed), but there will be rolling closures as the work continues to the north. Please also expect us to close some of the Cowboy bays as well.

We expect the closures will continue through March and perhaps into April.

Please be patient and as always be sure to check the club calendar before you come to the facility for scheduled events as well as construction closures.

Forming a Brush Remediation Committee

Club leadership has determined that proactive measures are required to reduce the potential of damage to club property by wildfires through a comprehensive brush remediation strategy.

We are looking for qualified and engaged club members to serve on a small committee that will report to the board of trustees and oversee this important initiative. Prospective volunteers should be willing to devote 3-5 days per year (mainly in the winter months) to 1.) Evaluate and prioritize the areas of the club that need attention; 2.) Recommend the best plan to address the work, and; 3.) To oversee the work, whether done by contractors or club volunteers.

Four general focus areas –

1. Protect important club infrastructure by pushing the brush perimeter back to an appropriate distance.
2. Clearing of fence lines and cutting appropriate roads/points of ingress for brush fire crews to have access to important infrastructure (where needed).
3. Undergrowth and dead fuel remediation and removal - including western red cedar abatement.
4. Long-term maintenance of above.

We are looking for 3-4 members for this committee, if you have the interest, available time and some experience, we would like to speak with you.
