Getting to Know 22 F-Class

22 F-Class (Rimfire F-Class) builds on the original F-Class founded by Canada's George "Farky" Farquharson for aging high power shooters using scopes and rests, by adapting this accessible, restsupported style to the popular .22LR cartridge, allowing fun, relatively low cost long range practice using skills needed in fullbore F-class.

The Idea: Borrow the accessible, rest-based F-Class format but use the relatively inexpensive .22LR, requiring similar skills for longer ranges (100-300 yards) as fullbore at 1000 yards.

Key Elements of .22 F-Class: Rifles utilizing .22LR ammunition.

Shooting done from prone position, using bipods or machine rests and sandbags. Distances generally longer than typical for .22LR ammunition and rifles. Shooting for score allowing sighting shots all done undertimed conditions. Skill development, i.e. developing wind/condition reading.

Equipment: uses .22LR rifles with scopes, front rests, and rear bags.

Distances: Fires at longer ranges than traditional .22 matches. The range used at the OKC Gun Club for this discipline is 100 yards.

Skill development: Develops the same precision, wind-reading, and aiming skills

as high power shooting but at a reduced cost.

.22 F-Class rimfire competition, officially known as F-Class SBR (Small Bore Rifle) is a relatively new shooting discipline provisional in 2017 and codified by the NRA within the last few years as a rimfire counterpart to high-power F-Class shooting.

The rimfire discipline follows the standard F-Class subdivisions adapted for smallbore:

- F-Target Rifle (F-T/R): Restricted to rifles using a bipod and rear bag.
- •F-Open (F-O): Allows more advanced equipment, such as heavy mechanical rests and rear bags.

The matches held at the OKC Gunclub-Smallbore division have also added a "Sporter" class designed for beginner or curious participants with a favorite rifle to experience competition in a friendly, supportive environment.

Course of Fire: Matches typically involve multiple 20-shot record relays at a paper target with unlimited sighter shots

within a 22 to 25 minute time frame.

Having said all that, we want to welcome all regular shooter and especially anyone curious about this simple game. We shoot on the SECOND SATURDAY of each month at the Smallbore/Airgun range on the east side of the club property off Hiawassee Road. Winter rules are currently in force meaning that the match will have an 010:00 start PROVIDING the forecast temperature at 010:00 is 45 degrees or higher. Here's hoping that all of you have had a safe and happy year. Looking forward to seeing everyone in 2026.

Forming a Brush Remediation Committee

Club leadership has determined that proactive measures are required to reduce the potential of damage to club property by wildfires through a comprehensive brush remediation strategy.

We are looking for qualified and engaged club members to serve on a small committee that will report to the board of trustees and oversee this important initiative. Prospective volunteers should be willing to devote 3-5 days per year (mainly in the winter months) to 1.) Evaluate and prioritize the areas of the club that need attention; 2.) Recommend the best plan to address the work, and; 3.) To oversee the work, whether done by contractors or club volunteers.

Four general focus areas –

- 1. Protect important club infrastructure by pushing the brush perimeter back to an appropriate distance.
- 2. Clearing of fence lines and cutting appropriate roads/points of ingress for brush fire
- crews to have access to important infrastructure (where needed).
- 3. Undergrowth and dead fuel remediation and removal including western red cedar abatement.
- 4. Long-term maintenance of above.

We are looking for 3-4 members for this committee, if you have the interest, available time and some experience, we would like to speak with you.

Since summer 2020, our Club has expanded training to meet community needs following the surge in firearm purchases. We launched "Cover Your Basics – Handgun," and in 2021 added

"Expand Your Basics – Handgun," SDA License Training, Home Defense – Shotgun, Home Defense – Carbine, and NRA Range Safety Officer. In 2025, we added SDA Refresher, Purchasing Your First Handgun, Personal Protection Inside the Home, Personal Protection Outside the Home, and courses from guest instructors. We will continue these programs and introduce additional offerings.

This coming year, Expand Your Basics - Handgun will be the NRA Basic Pistol Course. We will also offer more NRA courses, including NRA Instructor certifications in Personal Protection Inside the Home, Personal Protection Outside the Home, Basic Pistol, Basic Shotgun, Basic Reloading (metallic and shotshell), and Basic Rifle. In 2026, we will add NRA Home Firearm Safety and Handgun Cleaning. We are also hosting Glock courses again this year: the Gen 5 Armorer's course and the Low Profile Carry course.


