Oklahoma City Gun Club Now Offering NRA ARC Matches

The AR-15 has become America's most popular rifle, and the NRA America's Rifle Challenge (ARC) program offers a new, accessible way for owners to put their rifles to use. The ARC program blends marksmanship training with competition, aiming to appeal to both beginners and experienced shooters alike. Focused on safe, practical use of the AR-15 for recreation, self-defense, hunting, and sport shooting, ARC offers opportunities for shooters of all experience levels, including rimfire AR and PCC competitors.

This new match will be offered on the 4th Saturday of the month, beginning in July. Match program details are still being

worked out, so check the club website for updates. A club email notification will be sent with specific details as we near the date.

5-Stand Is Growing

Your participation in the monthly shoots and leagues enables 5-Stand to continually improve and add more shooting options. And thanks to that increased participation, 5-Stand was able to add a new machine this year, the Battue clay.

A Battue clay is a thin, fast, and often unpredictable clay target used in sporting clays that flies flat before turning, diving, or appearing to roll over at its peak. Due to their thin, roughly 9mm profile, they are fragile but hard to spot on edge. They simulate fast-diving birds or high-speed, diving, or dropping targets.

Currently, 5-Stand offers four clay types: normal, rabbit, midi's and Battue. When placed together these options can

create a challenging yet exciting course of fire for any level of shooter. Come on out and test your skills at the next monthly shoot (3rd Sunday of each month, \$10 per round) or look for the league options and maybe earn a perfect 25 coin too.

The April league wrapped up with 48 shooters participating. The league was held on Mondays and Tuesdays. Shooters saw 200 targets from eight different machines and four types of clays.

The 50 percent shooter was Mike Stevenson with a score of 101 and an average of 12.6. We look forward to welcoming even more participants in the upcoming leagues and monthly shoots.

June 2026 Construction Update

In January, the Board approved funding to continue modernizing the berms on the Action Shooting ranges—these are the six northernmost bays on Hiwassee Road, north of the Shotgun facility. Our target for 2026 was to complete the remaining northern bays. Mid-April, when I prepared the last construction update, I thought the project would be completed in May. Well, my optimism did not pan out as planned because the principal piece of equipment used by the contractor to harvest dirt for the berm broke, and its repair is taking longer than expected.

We are keeping the north ranges closed during the week, because the moment the equipment is repaired, work will resume. I am told there are only about 7-10 days of work remaining before we are complete. If true, this will complete the rear impact berm project, which began with the Muzzleloading berm in 2023, and the

Cowboy Action berm in 2024 and 2025. We appreciate your patience during the construction and the associated range closures.

Members are reminded that on all ranges, bullets must impact the berms and never the floor of any range. When using the Cowboy and Action Shooting bays, please place targets at the bottom of the berms. If you want to shoot the targets from a closer position, go downrange. You are not required to shoot from the covered portion (for those bays with covers). This ensures that all bullets impact the berms.

Please be patient, and as always, be sure to check the club calendar for scheduled events as well as construction closures before you come to the facility. We have a lot going on at the club, and we know it's frustrating to arrive and find out there are construction closures, workday projects, or other scheduled activities.

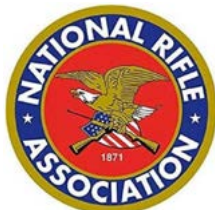


