Archery Division Ready for Great Season

The Archery Division has made improvements and expanded the existing ranges with a new walk-out range to the archery complex, now 6 ranges and over 60 targets in total. This lends itself to accommodate many shooters at the same time. The ranges include bag/block



targets positioned at lengths of 10 to 80 yards and 3D animal targets at a variety of distances (10-50yds).

Also, the archery division is well staffed to support Club Member needs for advise, coaching, equipment and clinics.

We now have an Archery Youth Team that will be competing with other area archery programs in OKC. Many planned events are in the works. We will be conducting two Oklahoma Archery Shooting Association competitions. A qualifying shoot in March and the State Championship in July. Five Club Fun Shoots will take place at the end of each month beginning in

March. A regional 4H club shoot, S3DA Championship, and a year end Bowhunter shoot (late August or early September) are also on the schedule. Last, we are looking to provide a Women's Shoot in mid to late September. Please check the Club Calendar for details on each event listed.

Skeet League

Spring Skeet League will start on Tuesday, March 18, Wednesday, March 19, and Thursday, March 20. at 6 p.m. each day. We shoot 50 targets (two rounds) per week for 10 weeks for a total of 500 targets. The cost to shoot the league is \$130. This covers 20 rounds of skeet, hotdogs each night, assorted meats for a potluck awards dinner, and awards for recognition of the top shooters and teams.

Military Bolt Action Benchrest

All of the marksmanship fundamentals come to bear in this discipline where sights are rough, triggers are heavy, the target is small, and recoil is a reality. It's a great way to develop skills which easily cross over to hunting and other marksmanship disciplines, on a budget.

These rifles are shot from a bench, with the support of a front rest (not a bipod), and a rear bag if desired.

Other equipment such as spotting scopes, sight black, recoil pads, and even shooting jackets are allowed. Hearing and Eye protection is required.

As a safety precaution, guns and ammo must be tested prior to shooting in the matches.

The course of fire is 10 shots for practice and 5 strings of 10 shots for record. The first two strings are shot for group size (smallest wins of course) and the final three strings are shot for score.

The target is the NRA SR-21 which has a 6.12" aiming black and only a .79" X-ring.

To keep things inexpensive and "fair to all," rifles may not be highly modified or "sporterized", though some small changes like front sight modification or minor trigger smoothing fits in the "ok" category of gun work. The spirit of competition dictates using "as issued" rifles.

If you like the idea of improving your marksmanship skills on a budget this is a great way to go. There is an OKC Gun Club MBABR Match on the first Saturday of the month at the East Benchrest Range.

5-Stand Summer League

5-Stand Summer League will be held starting June 2 on Mondays. Sign-up will be via email with fees due NLT the first day of shooting (2 Jun). The cost is \$50 per person, which includes the cost of clays and plaques for the top three shooters and anyone who shoots a perfect score of 25. You shoot two rounds a week, 25 clays per round with a total of 250 targets for the league. We need a minimum of 15 shooters for the league and will cut off at 40 shooters. Scores and standings will be emailed after each league night.

For those who have never shot 5-Stand, it is similar to Sporting Clays but without walking a course to different stations. Shooters will stand in a “window” and shoot clays launched from machines at different angles and locations. Shooters will repeat this action in five different “windows” that are located side by side.

Shooters will shoot five total clays from each window for a total of 25 clays. You load two shells in your shotgun each round. You may use any gauge shotgun.

The league begins at 4:30 p.m. each Monday. There are no teams so once you arrive, sign up to a squad, which is five shooters. Once a squad is filled, we will begin shooting. Make-up rounds will be shot at the end of weekly rounds or when a squad has an opening. League will run through the month of June.

5-Stand location: Go north on Hiwassee, turn into the Cowboy and Action Shooting Ranges. Once you are in the gate, turn left and follow the signs to 5-Stand.

Whether pistol, rifle, or multi-gun, there's something for everyone!

All matches are open to the public. Many shooters come to watch a match or two first to get some insight into the match flow. Hearing and eye protection are required at all times. Consult the Member Guide and the Action Shooting area of the club website for an overview of our matches.

Though this is not the venue to learn how to operate your firearm, it is an excellent environment to improve your skill and comfort using your firearm under the pressure of time and competition. We always welcome new shooters to our matches and provide match briefings to provide the ground rules. We have shooters of all skill levels, using a wide range of equipment.

For first-time shooters, we usually suggest starting with Steel Challenge or

GSSF matches, but the choice is yours. They are an excellent way to ease into the competitive environment, with less movement and equipment requirements. Also, they offer equipment divisions for rimfire pistol and rifles.
