Bohlman, Winner of US Army vs RAF Daily Telegraph Challenge Cup

Curtis Bohlman, a retired US Army colonel and member of the United States National Rifle Team, is the first American to clinch the trophy this century.

Competitors fired 15 shots at a distance of 500 yards. Col Bohlman scored a perfect 75 with 10 dead-central



V-bulls. This led to a tense tie-shoot because he ended up with the same score as a former RAF Tornado pilot, Rupert Clark. Bohlman held his nerve to win the shoot-off by a single point.

The competition took place at the historic Bisley Camp near Woking, England, in it's 157th Imperials Target Rifle Meeting. Sporting a bright red US Rifle Team polo shirt bearing the Betsy Ross Flag, an early variation of the Stars and Stripes with the stars arranged in a circle. Col Bohlman, an Afghanistan veteran, added, "I was a full-time Oklahoma Army National Guardsman for most of my

career. I was a recruiting commander for the state for a few years. I ended up being the personnel office for the state and was a regimental commander in Oklahoma for my final post.”

“Century was challenging for me all week long. We seem to have had more wind this year than the past two years,” Bohlman told the Telegraph afterwards, referring to the name of the Bisley range where the competition is shot.



The hallmarked sterling silver cup, engraved with the newspaper’s masthead and the legend “Presented to the National

Rifle Association in the centenary year 1960” is mounted on a base bearing the name of each of the previous 65 winners.

The Daily Telegraph Challenge Cup, alongside other newspapers’ trophies, forms the Howcroft Newspaper Aggregate, named after the late sports journalist and Telegraph shooting correspondent Les Howcroft. Col Bohlman Placed third in this aggregate with a field of 700 competitors.

When shown the NRA’s striking collection of sporting silverware, in which the Telegraph Challenge Cup trophy safely resides during the year, Col Bohlman remarked, “Unbelievable. This is awe-striking.”

Bohlman is an OKC Gun Club board member and co-chair of the High Power Rifle Division.





LAND RUN 2026 SASS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

It is the first day of September, and even though we have been working on preparation for the largest Cowboy Action Shooting match in the world, for the past ten months, we still have much to do to be ready for over 750 shooters from 47 states and two European countries to converge on The OKC Gun Club October 3 through 10.

October 4 and 5 is scheduled for the Wild Bunch National Championship, which is a speed-based competition using a Model 1911 pistol, a lever-action rifle, and either a Winchester Model 1897



or Model 12 pump shotgun or a double barrel shotgun.

We will shoot 5 stages on Sunday and 5 on Monday. Wild Bunch was started by the founders of The Single Action Shooting Society about 16 years ago; it was revamped two years ago to attract more shooters. This year we will have 122 shooters registered for The Wild Bunch competition.

On Tuesday October 6, the large group begins arriving, with over 750 shooters registered for the Cowboy Match.

Warmup matches and side matches on Tuesday and Wednesday will be very

hectic, with OKC Gun Club members and volunteers all pitching in to make our guests feel welcome.



The main cowboy match is Thursday, Friday and Saturday with three flights of competition each day. By the time we finish Saturday over 750 shooters will have shot approximately 300,000 rounds over seven days.

There will be 30 vendors selling guns, clothes and other various western themed goods. With 5 food trucks serving great food, everyone who can attend should leave happy.

Visitors and spectators are welcome. Just remember ear and eye protection.

If you are a club member who has not done his workday for 2026, this is a great opportunity. We will have a workday on Saturday, September 12, from 8:00 am until 2:00 pm; we'll also need volunteers to help during the match. Please contact J.R. Now it is time to start on the range preparations.

We will have a work-day on September 12 where we will be cleaning up the Cowboy, Action Pistol, 5-Stand, Smallbore & Airgun ranges – gathering all trash/hulls/brass in bays and small repair projects. Our last prep for the match will be Sept. 28-30 when we'll be setting targets and installing props. Finally, we'll need help with the actual running of the match,

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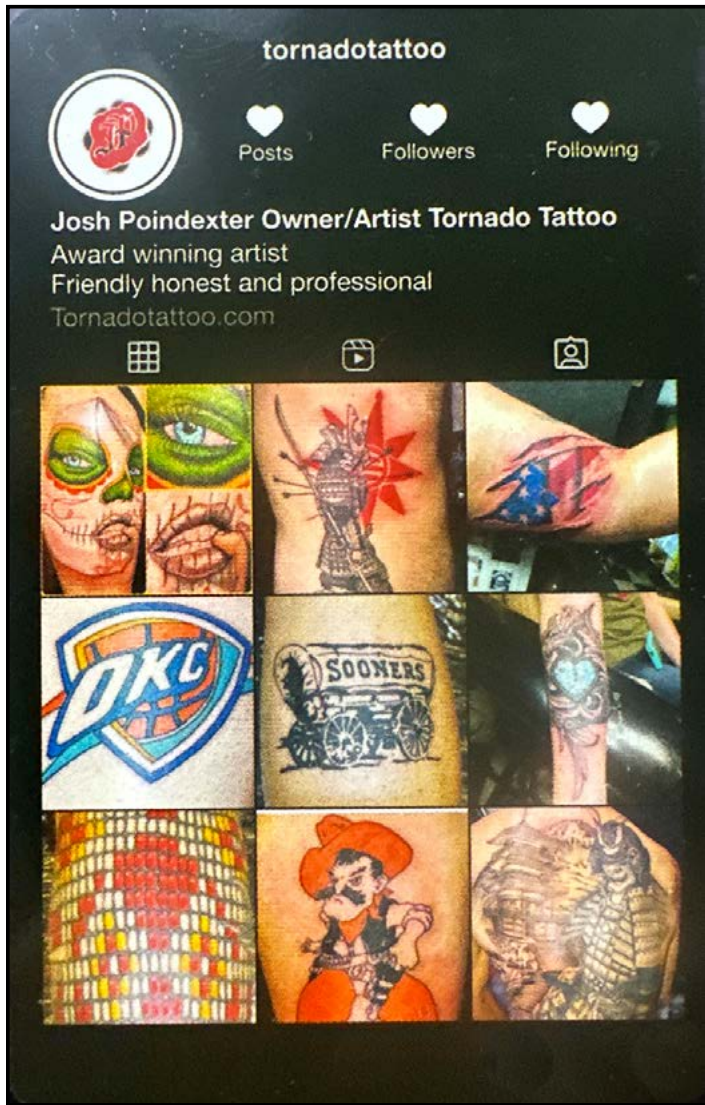
