1000 Yards - First Shot

Midafternoon on October 8th, a hushed crowd stood in anticipation of the report of the ceremonious first shot that would open the Oklahoma City Gun Club's newest addition, the High Power Rifle range's 1000yd line. The red and yellow wind flags indicated a four to six mile an hour quartering wind and agreed with the mirage: a left to right drift. The .308 Winchester's 168 grain bullet would travel 12 feet above the line of sight and drift more than 12 inches with a 1.7 second time of flight to the target. Our club's vice president, Mark Vaughan was on the gun – the silence was broken with the distinctive crack of a suppressed round headed down range. Earlier that afternoon President Suzi Rouse and VP Vaughan welcomed the crowd and recognized past presidents Pat Morris and Steve Baldwin who were present. Speeches referenced the club's 30-year-old decision to start putting money aside to purchase the property and the countless volunteer hours of surveying, planning, and hard work that made the range what it is today, much for the efforts of Division Chairman Kent Shomber. This just two years after the board's verdict to move ahead with the project. Though we don't yet have the infrastructure in place to hold large matches, we do have an operational range complete with steel targets and a high-tech electronic target system for club member use.

After the opening of the range, rather than celebrating with cake and punch, we conducted range safety orientations and 1000yd certifications for the members present, 47 in total. For years the division has been conducting "Range Orientations" for club members, required for unsupervised use of the range. The focus of this orientation was safety and instruction necessary to properly open, occupy and close the range after use. With the 1000yd extension, additional instruction including a marksmanship proficiency check was added to the legacy orientation. Those members already having gone through the original orientation were allowed to proceed to the second part, the "1000yd Certification", without going back through the former training, but some wanted a refresher.

We conduct orientations after all of our matches, so please look at our schedule of events posted on High Power Division web page of the club web site. Most of the matches start at about 9:00 and conclude a little after noon. Be sure to be early enough that you don't miss the end of the match because if no one is present for an orientation by the time we're done, we'll not hang around. Additionally, we have been discussing conducting orientations during our "down months" of December, January, because we normally don't have matches these months. Monitor club emails, the Primer, and the club web site for announcements of these dates. When you attend an orientation, you will need to bring a rifle and all gear to set up for a 1000yd shot. Your ammunition (as few as 20 rounds may be sufficient) must be capable of breaking the sound barrier at 1000yds to work on our electronic targets, but even if it won't, we've qualified members using the steel targets only. Please have at least a 200yd zero on your rifle and an idea of your muzzle velocity. Most of the members we qualified last month had ballistics charts for their guns which helped, but it's not absolutely necessary. Be sure to look at the rules posted on our web page for ammo limitations. The orientation and 1000yd certification takes about an hour for just a few members, but will go longer if more are in line to certify. Certification will enable you to use the range at your leisure, outside of sanctioned events.

Oh, and the first shot? I guess you just had to be there. \square



NRA/ CMP Action Pistol Year end Summary for 2023

It turned out to be a great year! We had members of the Oklahoma City Gun Club attend several National Matches. All of these matches have four events in them. The Mover, The Barricades, The Plates and The Practical. Each event has 48 shots in them and a total possible score of 1920 and 192 Xs.



The first National match was The Crawfish Cup in Louisiana near Lake Charles. There were 82 competitors who showed up for this match. Si Fentress, who is a board member at the OKCGC, shot a score of 1815-132x out of a possible 1920-192x. J.P. Lefebvre, also a member of the OKCGC, shoots for the Marine Corp Reserves and is an Oklahoma City Police officer, shot a score of 1767-84x. The Crawfish match was the first match and then the Louisiana State Championship match occurred. Si shot 1704-106x and J.P. shot 1719-92x. Si won the Regional and State Sharpshooter Class. Both of these guys will be moving up to the expert class real quick. Sand bagging will be over! Chuck Abston was also there. The prize table was great! There were lots of Zero ammo that was passed out and other fine products from Dillon, Gaff and Sons and many others.

The Flagler Cup, used as a warm up match for the Bianchi Cup, is held at the Pioneer Gun Club Kansas City, Missouri. J.P. shot a score of 1778-105x and Si shot a score of 1683-103x. There were 103 competitors at this match. Chuck was there also.



Next up is the biggest match of the year - The Bianchi Cup held in Columbia, Missouri at the Green Valley Rifle and Pistol Club in May. The Bianchi Cup is the International Action Pistol Championship match of the year. Competitors come from all over the world for this match. The

weather was perfect. The ranges were perfect. This event, for the first time, was conducted by the CMP (Civilian Marksmanship Program) perfect...Yeah!

Si won the Sharpshooter Class and had a score of 1841-117x and he was third in the Grand Senior category with that same score. J.P. shot a 1781-96x in the Expert class. Salli Wandke, also with the Oklahoma City Gun Club, shot a score of 1361-56x. Chuck was there also.

There was a raffle for a CMP 1911 pistol. The Sponsors tables were outstanding. There were 20 Bricks (500 rounds) each of CMP standard velocity 22 ammo for lucky winners in the drawing. Zero Products gave away lots of 9mm and 38 super loaded ammo. The Sponsor tables were so loaded with products it was hard picking a product when your name was called and there were certificates for discounts on all kinds of sponsor products. Overall CMP did an outstanding job conducting this very important event.



And, then, there was the Cameron Cup Regional Match held at the Green Valley Rifle and Pistol Club in Columbia, Missouri on September 30. There were 52 shooters for this match. Si shot a score of 1717-108x. Chuck was there also 1621-66x.

The Show Me Cup shot on October 1st is the last big match of the year and is held back at The Pioneer Gun Club, Kansas City, Missouri. There were 56 competitors at this match. J.P. received his new classification card and it is Master. He shot a perfect score of 480-48 in the Plates event. His total score for the match was 1877-124x. Great job J.P. Si was 4th in the expert class with a score of 1814-107x. Chuck was there also.

There is interest by competitors in shooting an NRA Sanctioned Match on April 14, 2024 here at the OKCGC - the weekend before the Crawfish Cup on April 19-20, 2024. I have changed our match date from April 7th to April 14, 2024.
