Fall is Here – and Hunting Season is Just Around the Corner!

The ranges will be full of eager shooters siting in rifles and honing their skills. With that said, it is paramount that members are aware of the range rules at the Oklahoma City Gun Club. Specifically, as it pertains to fully auto fire. Recently we had members attempting to use devices to simulate automatic fire, which is a violation of Rule 13 of the General Rules of Conduct which states:

#13. There will be no firing of automatic firearms on the ranges by anyone at any time. This prohibition includes devices that simulate automatic fire, including (but not limited to) bump-stocks, binary triggers, or any other such devices.

Those members who were shooting full auto had to appear before the board and had their membership revoked for the rest of the year. There is a no-tolerance policy for violation of any range rules, and we take all rule violations seriously. Don't be "that member"!

I would remind everyone to refer to the OKC Gun Club Membership Guide that is posted on the website to familiarize themselves with the range rules. If you don't know the rules on a specific range, contact the division chair, and they will be more than happy to educate you. Find the <u>club membership guide</u> here>



The Cowboy Action division has been hard at work all summer for the 2025 Single Action Shooting Society (SASS) National Championships of Cowboy Action and Wild Bunch Shooting which will be held October 4-11.

We currently have 741 registered shooters for the Cowboy Championship and 110 for the Wild Bunch Championship including over 100 campers, making it the largest match our club hosts and the largest Cowboy Action match in the country.

Now is the time we start on the range preparations and volunteer scheduling. We will have our final range work-day on September 27 where we will be cleaning up the Cowboy, Action Pistol, 5-Stand, Smallbore and Airgun ranges such as mowing, weedeating, trimming trees, gathering all trash/hulls/brass in bays and small repair projects. We will work from 8:00 am to about 2:00 pm. Lunch and drinks will be provided for workers. Please call J.R. Hile if you have questions about the work day at 405-409-9442.

The final step in preparing for the match will be Sept. 29-30 when we will set targets and install props. Finally, we'll need help with the actual running of the match, our core group of 40 cowboys will pre-shoot the match Oct. 2-4. We'll need a



Safety Reminders

It is important to remind our members and club users of the following:

- 1. It is the responsibility of the gun owner to stay up-to-date on the latest safety bulletins, recalls and other information pertaining to the firearms and ammunition they bring to the Oklahoma City Gun Club for use and competition.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the gun owner to ensure that all firearms and ammunition used at the Oklahoma City Gun Club are in good working condition and are safe to use.
- 3. If there exists doubt about the safety of any firearm or ammunition, the member/user should refrain from using that firearm or ammunition at the Club until a determination is made by the manufacturer, a competent gunsmith, or other professional as to the safety of that firearm or ammunition.




