

# 2023 Spring Skeet League

Our spring league for 2023 will start on Tuesday, March 21<sup>st</sup> and Thursday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>. Robert Buswell will be handling the squadding and the sign-up sheets. If you haven't shot with us in the past, come on out, we guarantee you will have a good time. New shooters are welcome, there is always someone willing to help and give advice. This league is designed for our members to meet each other and make new friends. While it is competitive, the main objective is to have fun!

We anticipate at least 100 shooters wanting to participate in the spring league this year. We are limited to 100 shooters (50 per night), so sign up early. The 2023 Spring League will shoot at 6:00 PM. We shoot 50 targets (two rounds) per week for 10 weeks for a total of 500 targets. The cost to shoot the league this year will be \$120. This covers 20 rounds of skeet, hotdogs each night, assorted meats for a pot luck dinner, and trophies for the top shooters and teams.

Sign-up will be located at the shotgun division clubhouse. There will be sign-up sheets for each night (Tuesday or Thursday) with places for 10 teams of five shooters per team. Please sign-up by providing your name, phone number, and email address.

**FEES & TOKENS:** Those who have signed-up to shoot on Tuesdays will need to be at the clubhouse on March 14<sup>th</sup> from 4:30 PM to 6:00 PM to exchange fees for tokens. Thursday night shooters will need to be at the clubhouse on March 16<sup>th</sup>, same time period, same purpose.

## **REMEMBER...**

- **Do not sign-up for the league if you can't shoot on your squad's designated night. Another aspect of shooting in skeet league is experiencing team camaraderie.**
- **Everyone should show-up for league by 6 PM... members of one team are supposed to pull and score for the other team and vice versa.**
- **You are allowed to shoot make-up rounds but try and have them shot in a few weeks, if nothing is turned in, then dog scores will be entered.**
- **You are encouraged to pre-shoot rounds for future planned absences.**
- **Score sheets for make-up rounds and pre-shot rounds should be noted and dated as such and pinned to the bulletin board where weekly scores are posted.**
