

# 2025 Spring Skeet League

Our spring league for 2025 will start on Tuesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, and Thursday, March 20<sup>st</sup>. Robert Buswell will be handling sign-up and league operation. If you haven't shot with us in the past, come on out, we guarantee you will have a good time. New shooters are welcome; this league is designed for our members to meet each other and make new friends. While it is competitive, the main objective is to have fun!

The 2025 Spring League will shoot at 6:00 PM. We shoot 50 targets (two rounds) per week for 10 weeks for a total of 500 targets. The total cost to shoot the league this year will be \$130. This covers 20 rounds of skeet, hotdogs each night, assorted meats for a pot luck awards dinner, and medallions for the recognition of top shooters and teams.

Sign-up will be located on the north porch of the large shotgun division clubhouse. Please sign-up by providing your name, email address, and phone number. We anticipate about 120 shooters wanting to participate in the spring league this year... so sign-up promptly! Tuesday and Thursday evenings are traditional favorites so if you and your team are okay with shooting on Wednesday evening please do so, it will help to ease the crunch.

**FEES & TOKENS:** Those who have signed-up to shoot will need to be at the clubhouse on either Tuesday, March 11<sup>th</sup> or Thursday, March 13<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM to pay league fees. It doesn't matter which night you are shooting, just be sure to come in and pay your fees!

## **REMEMBER...**

- Do not sign-up for the league if you can't shoot on your squad's designated night. An aspect of shooting in skeet league is experiencing team camaraderie... so shoot with your team!
- Everyone should show-up for league by 6 PM... members of one team are supposed to pull and score for the other team and vice versa... if you're on time, you're late!
- You are limited to shooting lead shot and nothing larger than 7½ shot.
- You are allowed to shoot make-up rounds but try and have them shot in a few weeks, if nothing is turned in when scoring is finalized, then dog scores will be entered.
- You are encouraged to pre-shoot rounds for planned absences.
- Score sheets for make-up rounds and pre-shot rounds should be noted and dated as such and pinned to the bulletin board where weekly scores are posted.
